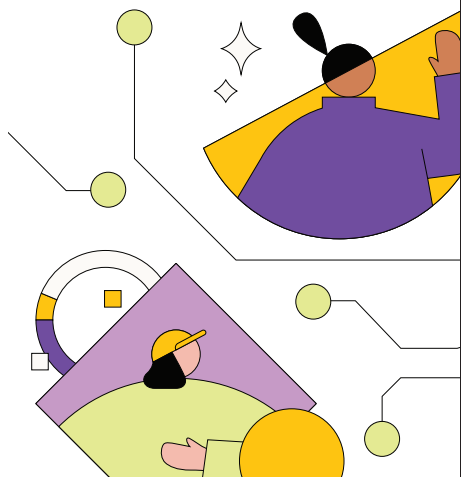
**Easter**

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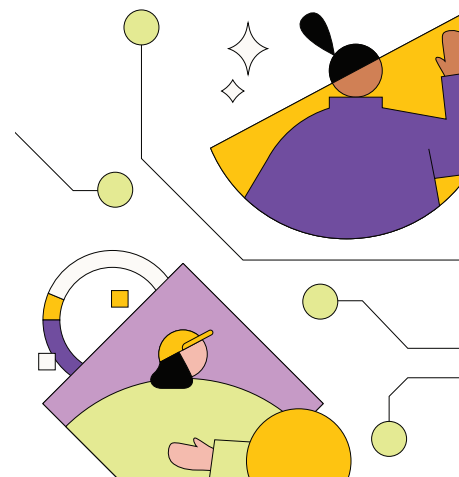
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ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



## Morning Time

## Drive Time
