Show Graphic: Preschool Rules

- Rule number four is: take care of the room and the toys! (Shake your finger while you say the rule.)
- The last rule is: join in! (Spread your arms wide and bring them in.) Let's all join in right now and stand up for worship.

APPLICATION

Wow! Jesus was kind and loving to the man even though nobody else was. Jesus touched the man even though nobody else would. Jesus made the man all better when nobody else could. And, when we're sad or sick, or tired, we can know that Jesus loves us too. Jesus loves you, and me, and everyone in the world! Jesus loves everyone. Who does Jesus love? (everyone!)

Bible Verse

(Open Bible.) Look, there is even a Bible verse to remind us!

Show Verse: "Be kind and loving to each other." Ephesians 4:32

Let's all stand up and say that with motions. Follow me.

"Be kind and loving (cross hands over chest)
To each other" (spread arms out)
Ephesians 4:32 (Open hands like a book)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, then have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold hands, and close their eyes.)

Great job, everybody! Let's pray.

PRAYER

Dear God, thank you for Jesus. Jesus was kind and loving to the sick man even though nobody else was. Help us to love everyone the way Jesus loves them. In Jesus' name, we pray, Amen.

BIG GROUP GAME

Jesus helped and loved the sick man when no one did, Let's play a game to help us remember to love others too! I have a bunch of different things. Your job is to help me decide which things help others who are hurt, and which things don't. I will put helping things in this first aid kit (Hold up first aid kit.) But here's the catch ... I am going to be blindfolded and will have only one minute to sort through all the objects. Do you kids think you can help me sort all of this in one minute? Ok! If I pull something out that you would use to help others, I want

you to yell, "Yes!" If it isn't something you would use to help others, I want you to yell, "No!" Got it? Ok! Here we go! (Put blindfold on. Hold Items up on at a time,)

Show Countdown: 1 minute timer

Great job! Now it's Circle Time! When you hear the music walk slowly to a circle and sit right down.
