Now, you might remember how God chose a man named Abraham and promised to bless the whole world through his family. Abraham's family eventually became known as the Israelites, and the number of people continued to grow and grow. But the Israelites had to live in slavery in Egypt—for hundreds of years! At last, God sent a man named Moses to lead the Israelite people to freedom. Moses led God's people into the wilderness, where God gave them water and food.
