Today we're in the book of Proverbs (hold up Bible), which is a collection of wise sayings. Many of these sayings come from King Solomon. One thing you should know about Solomon is that he became king at a very young age. He was worried about leading an entire nation with so little experience. One night, God spoke in a dream and told Solomon that he could have ANY gift he wanted. Solomon asked God for wisdom so he could be the best leader for his people. Sure enough, God made Solomon one of the wisest people who ever lived. Many of the things Solomon learned and said were written down here in the book of Proverbs, along with others. These sayings can help us understand how to make wise decisions in our lives today. Let's see what our friends have to say about today's Bible story!
