We want to have all the fun here at Flatiron Kids Ministry! We have a few things that we like to commit to make sure everybody has a good time.

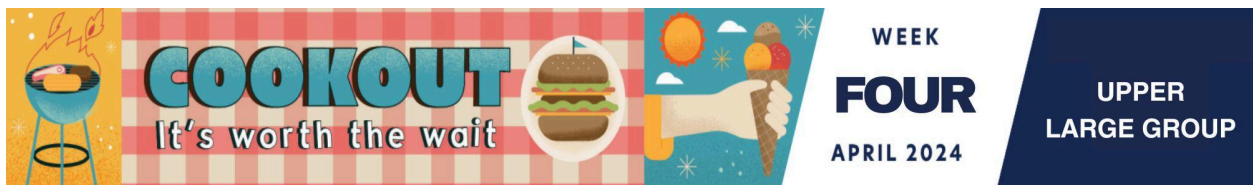
#### **Flatiron Kids Are:**

Thank you so much for taking care of our friends! Another way we can help our friends is by praying for them. This week, see if you can remember to pray with your family for our friends at One Child.

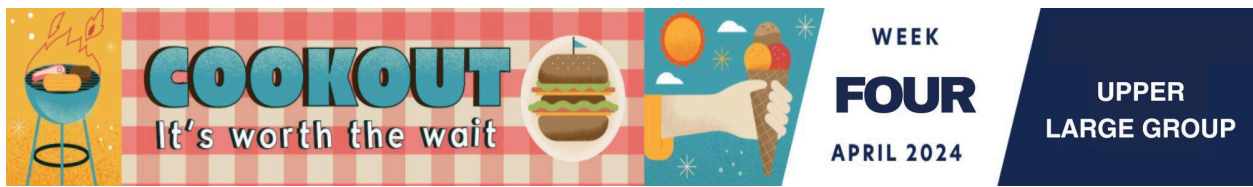
