QUALIFICATIONS

- You love God + are committed to growing in your personal relationship with Jesus
- You care about the next generation
- You are committed to consistently investing + caring for your small group for a minimum of one year
- You understand + embrace the values/vision of Flatirons
- You completed + passed the application, background check, interview + leader agreement process

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Show up on time for pre-service team huddles (830/1030a)
- Come prepared knowing the weekly materials for your group (flatironskidmin.com)
- Connect + communicate with your coach/team
- Attend the appropriate trainings, gatherings + events whenever necessary

LEAD SMALL

- Be Present
 - Connect their faith to a community by showing up predictably, mentally + randomly
- Create a Safe Place
 - Clarify their faith as they grow by leading the group,
 respecting the process and guarding the heart
- Partner with Parents
 - Nurture an everyday faith by cueing the parent, honoring the parent + reinforcing the family
- Make It Personal
 - Inspire their faith by your example by living in community, setting priorities + being real
- Move Them Out
 - Engage their faith in a bigger story by moving them to someone else, moving them to be the church and moving them to what's nedxt



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LEAD UP

- Read through your curriculum + materials ahead of time
- Dress appropriately for the part
- Consume snacks + drinks before kids arrive to their space
- Attend the Team Huddle with your fellow small group leaders at it's designated time (this will be where the coach/staff will prepare you for the day)

WARM UP

- Grab your name tag + wear it
- Get your small group space ready
- Make sure that you have all your supplies + curriculum
- Discard your snacks before the kids arrive

SHOW UP

- Welcome
 - Check-in begins 20 minutes before each service; so, be ready for children to come in
 - Prepare for the Opening Small Group activity with your group + do check-in with your roster sheets
- Large Group
 - Sit together with your small group + model good
 listening skills when engaging in worship + lesson
- Small Group
 - It's time to dig into activities + discussion questions to connect with your group because this is where the magic happens
 - Don't be systematic or robotic in how you lead these moments...be natural
- Closing
 - Use time to connect with parents while they pick up their kids
 - Clean up area + set up for next group before leaving for the day
