WELCOME

Welcome boys and girls. I'm so glad you're here! Before we get started with today's lesson, let's review our room rules so that we can have a fun day!

RULES

Show Graphic: Preschool Rules

Let's put on our moose antlers and call our friend Dan-o to help us. (Thumbs on either side of your head with fingers splayed.) Daaaaaan-oooooo! (Have kids participate as you do motions.)

- The first rule is: be a friend! (Give yourself a hug as you say the rule.)
- Rule number two is: be safe! (Do baseball gesture for safe.)
- The next rule is: be a good listener! (Cup your ears.)
- Rule number four is: take care of the room and the toys! (Shake your finger while you say the rule.)
- The last rule is: join in! (Spread your arms wide and bring them in.) Let's all join in right now and stand up for worship.

Today's true story from the Bible begins with a woman named Hannah. In our story, Hannah is feeling sad. Let's visit Ollie and our friends to hear more about Hannah.

APPLICATION

Hannah knew that God loved her, and she could pray and talk to God about anything. God loves you and [Bottom Line] God loves me. That means we can pray and talk to God about anything too! We can pray and talk to God when we feel happy, or sad, or frustrated. No matter how we're feeling, we can talk to God because God loves you and God loves me. Say it with me "God loves me!" (Kids repeat)

Bible Verse

(Open Bible.) Look, there is even a Bible verse to remind us!

Show Verse: "I will always love you." Jeremiah 31:3

Let's all stand up and say that with motions. Follow me.

"I (point up with both index fingers)

Will always (circle one index finger in the air)

love you" (cross hands over your heart)

Matthew 5:16 (Open hands like a book)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast)

Great job, everybody! Let's play a game, then we will pray.

BIG GROUP GAME

Hannah talked to God when she was sad because she knew she could talk to God anytime, anywhere, and about anything. Let's play a game about feelings. This is my "sad face/happy face" stick. When I tell you something that makes you feel happy, I want you to jump up and show me your happy face. If I tell you something sad, sit down and show me your sad face. Let's practice...

Today I am going to the ice cream shop! (turn stick to "happy" face, demonstrate jumping up and smiling). Great job everyone let's keep going!

- My favorite toy got broken
- We are going on a field trip at school
- I have a tummy ache
- I saw my best friend at the park today
- My lunch tasted yucky
- I wanted to go swimming, but it is raining
- I help my little brother tie his shoe
- God loves me!

That was fun! Thanks for playing. God love us no matter how we are feeling. Let's pray just like Hannah did! Fold your hand and close your eyes.

PRAYER

"Dear God, we're thankful we can talk to You when we are happy, sad, excited, or scared. We can talk to You anytime, anywhere, and about anything. You're the best, God! In Jesus' name, we pray, amen.
