

# Monday | Start the Glow Party!



**WHAT YOU NEED:** Glow sticks, mini traffic cones, glow-in-the-dark tape, water bottles (for water bottle flips), glow in the dark bowling set

## WHAT YOU DO:

- Allow kids to rotate through the following game stations, spending a set amount of time at each before moving to the next:
  - Glow-in-the-Dark Ring Toss:
    - Set up a ring toss station with mini traffic cones and glow sticks formed into rings.
    - Kids take turns trying to toss the glow stick rings onto the cones to score points.
  - Glow-in-the-Dark Life-Sized Games:
    - Use glow-in-the-dark tape to create life-sized tic-tac-toe and hopscotch.
    - Use glow sticks formed into rings to play tic-tac-toe.
  - Glow-in-the-Dark Water Bottle Flips and Limbo:
    - Empty several water bottles partially (1/3 remaining)
    - Insert glow sticks to create a glowing effect.
    - Put together several glow sticks to create a limbo bar and have the kids cycle through
    - Kids take turns flipping the bottles to try and make them land upright.
    - If a kid lands it upright, they go under the limbo bar and keep trying to go through the cycle as many times as possible
  - Glow-in-the-Dark Bowling
    - Set up glow-in-the-dark bowling set using provided balloon pumps
    - Let kids take turns bowling
