Thursday | Small Group



WHAT YOU NEED: Envelope, Everyone's Invited Activity Page, colored cardstock paper, markers, glue sticks, and stickers.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Gather kids in a circle. Double check to see if any of your kids have food allergies. Pass out snacks and water.
- Help kids open snacks as needed.
- Enjoy the snack with your group. Once everyone is settled, begin the small group activity.
- Provide one envelope and one "You're Invited" card for each kid.
- Encourage kids to glue their card to a contrasting color of paper.
- Let kids decorate their card by adding "confetti" (dots with markers to the corners in two or three colors).
- Explain to the kids how to place the card inside the envelope, fold it closed, and seal it with a sticker.
- Tell kids to flip over the sealed invitation to create the "address" side. Instruct them
 to draw a small square in the top right-hand corner and add a fun sticker as their
 stamp.
- Then, draw in three lines for the address.
- If they have time left, kids can decorate the outside of the envelope with markers or stickers.
- Instruct kids to write their names on the back of the envelope and set aside in a designated area for pick up.

WHAT YOU SAY: Friends, your envelopes look great! We have been learning all week about Jesus and how everyone is invited to the party because everyone can follow Jesus. Every single person is included. We don't want the party to end, and want to see you back this weekend- and every weekend! Who could you invite to come with you to church this weekend?

PRAYER: Dear God, thank You for our time together! Thank You for the good news that You made a way for us to be with You forever. Help us to not keep this light and joy to ourselves. Anytime we have an opportunity to show others the joy You give us, help us to be bold. Let Your Holy Spirit give us confidence so that every day we tell ourselves, 'You can be a party starter.'
