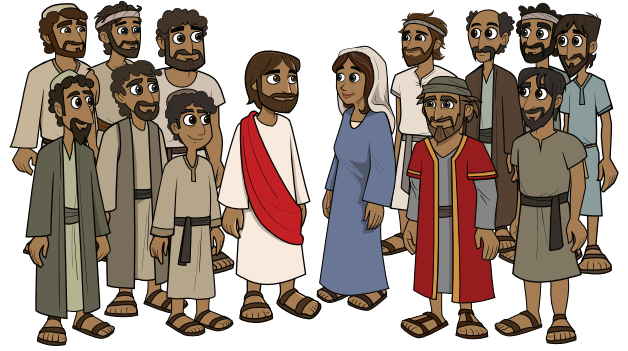
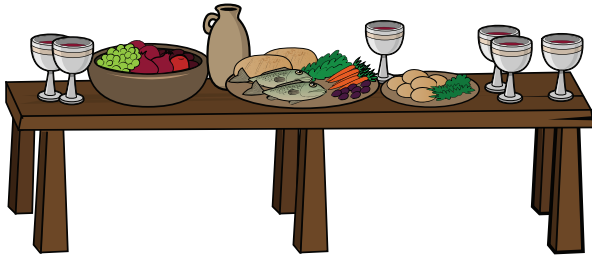




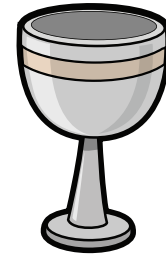
1. A bride and groom had a party to celebrate their wedding.



2. Jesus, his friends, the disciples, and His mom Mary were there.



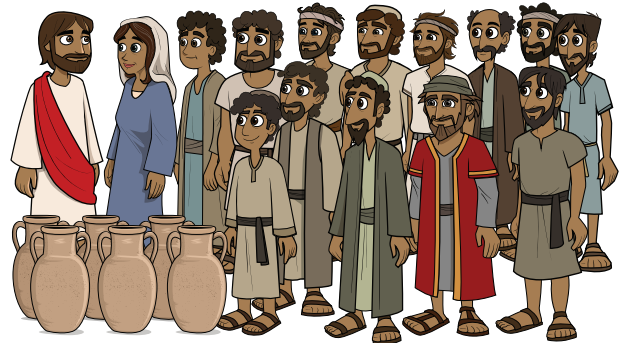
3. They had special food and a special wedding drink.
