Week 1

Show Graphic: Elementary Room Expectations

Game Time

OK everyone, if you think about it, the most joyful news of all is that God sent Jesus to be our Savior. And what better way to celebrate than with Christmas in July?

Show Graphic: Game time with Christmas music

So I figure let's celebrate the good news—even if it's a little early! Ha! We'll kick things off with a Christmas party game that I call 'Hungry Reindeer.' I need 2 helpers come join me at the table and stand in front of a plate. (choose 2 kids or volunteers to the table).

Have 2 pre-set stations with a paper plate, two red Solo® cups, and a reindeer antler headband.

All right, reindeer. Go ahead and put the red cups over your hands like they're your hooves. (Demonstrate.) "In just a minute, I'll dump a bunch of marshmallows—I mean reindeer food—on the table. When I say 'go,' you'll try to gather as many marshmallows—I mean REINDEER FOOD—on your plate as you can. You must use your hooves, and you can't slide the pieces of reindeer food onto your plate—you have to pick them up. When all the food is gathered, we'll see who has the most on their plate. That person will be the winner! "Any questions? (Pause for responses.) Let's play then! Hooves up, everyone! Three . . . two . . . one . . . GO!

(Dump the marshmallows in the middle of the table. Watch to make sure they aren't just sliding and scooping the marshmallows onto their plates. When all the marshmallows are on the plates, the game is over. If game is taking longer than expected, you can also begin a

10-second countdown and end the game. When the game is over, do a rough count of marshmallows on the kids' plates and award the winner.)

Show Series Graphic: Start the Party-Celebrate the Good News

Since we're celebrating Christmas in July, what story do you think we're talking about today? (Pause for responses.) Yep! Christmas. The truth is, the story of Jesus' birth can give us joy all the time—and not just during the holidays! The Christmas story reminds us how much God loves us, which is what can give us true, lasting joy no matter what's happening around us.

(Hold up Bible.) When we look at God's Big Story in the Bible (hold up Bible), we see how God had a plan to bless the whole world through Abraham's family. Abraham's family grew and became a nation called the Israelites. Sadly, the people kept turning away from God. Eventually, they were attacked by other nations. But God still had a good plan!

But God spoke through people called prophets and promised to send a Rescuer. After hundreds of years, when the time was right, God sent an angel to a young woman named Mary. The angel told Mary that she would give birth to God's very own Son, Jesus.

We can think about the way Jesus lived and the way He showed us how to love the people around us. When we remember that Jesus came to bring love, joy, and forgiveness into the world, we can find lots of opportunities to spread that joy to others.
