Today I get to tell you about the very first miracle Jesus performed. We can read about it in the Bible, in the book of John. (*Hold up Bible.*) This miracle took place at a really joyful event where lots of people had gathered. Any guesses as to what it might have been? I'll give you a hint. A man....a woman....love...forever.... What kind of occasion do you think people were celebrating? (*Pause for responses.*) Right—a wedding! Let's check out what Jesus did at this wedding.
