We wrap up the month with the biggest celebration ever in Revelation 21, 22:1-5. John received visions from God about all the things that would one day come, some of which was easier to understand than others. However, John did write that one day there will be no more pain and sadness, and that God will live with us forever. **Bottom Line: Celebrate what God will do.** When you look at life through current situations, it may be harder to find joy and celebrate, especially if you don't see a way out. Whenever we focus on the things that God has already done for us however, it can help us remember all that God can do and will do in our lives. Now that's something to celebrate!

Show Series Graphic: Start the Party- Celebrate the Good News

"Today we'll be looking at the very last book of the Bible, Revelation. (Hold up Bible.) The book of Revelation was originally a letter written by a man named John. John wrote this letter to a group of churches in Asia Minor, which is a part of the world that we know today as Turkey.

The Romans had taken John to live on the Island of Patmos... which was basically like putting him in prison. They did this to stop John from telling people about Jesus. John wasn't stuck behind bars, but he couldn't go anywhere. Let's check out our Bible story.
