Week 1

We start the month in Luke 2:41-52. Mary, Joseph, and Jesus had just traveled to Jerusalem for the Passover Feast and were headed home. Except...Jesus was no longer with them. Instead, He was at the temple, listening and asking questions. Jesus knew how important it was to gain wisdom. When we ask God for wisdom, we will find it too.

Wisdom is worth searching for. Think back to when you were a kid, playing pretend as you went off in search of hidden treasures. Remember the joy and excitement you got as you dug deeper and deeper into the clues—and maybe even the earth? Searching for wisdom, in a way, is like finding that hidden treasure. When we find God's wisdom, its riches are infinitely more valuable.

WEEKLY COLLECTION CARDS

Your families are learning about their place in God's family all month long in the auditorium. We will also be learning about that here in our rooms. We all have things we spend time doing—going to school, sports, or just hanging out. But God made us for more than that. When we follow him, he teaches us to become more and more like Jesus every day.

WK 1: Identity – I am His child. God is the Father.

INTRO 1 minute

Our story today is from the book of Luke in the Bible. (Hold up Bible.) This book was written by a man named Luke who wanted to share the amazing things Jesus did and said.

If we look back to the very beginning of the Bible, we see how God made the world and everything in it—including people. But people turned away from God and tried to do things their own way. Still, God had a good plan to bring people back into relationship.

When the time was right, God sent Jesus to be our Rescuer. Let's check out this week's Bible story.

Jesus is God's Son, but still, He grew and learned! Jesus knew that **[Bottom Line] wisdom** is worth searching for. It was really important to Jesus to grow in wisdom. And we are God's children too, so that's definitely something we should do too. Wisdom is about more than just being smart or knowing lots of things. Wisdom is about finding out what you should do and doing it. We can talk to wise people—people who love God and who show God's love to others. We can also learn from the times we make mistakes. We can ask God to help us make a different choice the next time."

Remember, we can ALWAYS pray and ask God to give us wisdom. All wisdom comes from God to begin with!

Memory Verse

Show Verse: 1 John 3:1

There is so much to explore when it comes to the world God has made and the way God wants us to live. It can feel overwhelming sometimes when we don't know what to do, but God is there to give us the answers we need because He is a good father, and he loves us.

Check out our Memory Verse, 1 John 3:1. Your family is also learning this verse in the auditorium all month long. This month, we will learn some motions too to help us remember the verse. Stand up and do what I do.

See (make hands into circles and look through like binoculars)

What great love the Father (circle arms wide and give yourself a hug)

Has lavished on us (wiggle fingers high and bring low)

That we should be called point to chest with thumbs)

Children (pretend to rock a baby in your arm)

Of God (point up with both index fingers)

1 John 3:1 (open hands like a book.)

Dear God, thank you for being a good father. We know that all wisdom comes from You. We want to live with Your wisdom each day. Help us to search for wisdom by spending time with wise people, and by praying and talking to You. Help us to grow in wisdom like Jesus did. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name.
