# SEPTEMBER 2024 WEEK 1

We start the month in Matthew 5:14-16 with the Sermon on the Mount. In this passage, Jesus announced to the crowd, "You are the light of the world." Each of us can shine God's light to the world around us. When we shine our light by living God's way, we bring glory to God and show people what God is like. **You can shine God's light.** God didn't give us light so that it could be hidden. God gave us light so that we could shine brightly . . . and so that the world could see Who God is. When we look around and identify those who could use some light in their lives—and then do something about it—we reflect God's light.

**INTRO 1 minute** 

Our story today is from the book of Luke in the Bible. (Hold up Bible.) This book was written by a man named Luke who wanted to share the amazing things Jesus did and said.

If we look back to the very beginning of the Bible, we see how God made the world and everything in it—including people. But people turned away from God and tried to do things their own way. Still, God had a good plan to bring people back into relationship.

When the time was right, God sent Jesus to be our Rescuer. Let's check out this week's Bible story.

When you choose to share what God has given you and love like Jesus, you shine His light everywhere you go. [Bottom line]You can shine God's light.

Compassion means caring enough to do something about someone else's needs. We can find out how to do that by looking at the way Jesus lived. Jesus showed us what it looks like to love others and treat others the way we want to be treated. He's the light of the world, and He showed us how to share His light by showing compassion to the people around us.

**Memory Verse** 

**Show Verse: Matthew 5:16** 

We can show people that we care about them by noticing what they need and then doing something to help. Our Memory Verse for this month is Matthew 5:16. Let's learn it together:

Let your light shine so others can see it. Then they will see the good things you do. And they will bring glory to your Father who is in heaven.'" (Matthew 5:16, NIrV)

This week, as you spend time at school, in your neighborhood, or at home, take time to notice the people around you. See if there's someone you know who's feeling left out or sad. Think about what you could do to show them love, just like Jesus did. That's how you shine Jesus' light. Let's pray and ask God to help us do that

Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to be our Savior. Thank You for the way Jesus showed love and compassion, and for the example He gave us of how we should treat other people. Please help us to shine Your light to the people around us every single day. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
