For week 4, we head to 2 Corinthians 1:3-4. Paul was writing a letter to the church in Corinth in which he shared about the troubles he and Timothy had faced. Yet in the midst of all their difficulties, Paul and Timothy were still able to praise God because of the comfort God offered them. In this passage, Paul encouraged the believers in Corinth to offer comfort to others who were in trouble because of the comfort they had experienced from God.

Comfort others the way God comforts you. What brings you the most comfort? Maybe it's a blanket, ice cream, or giving your pet a big squeeze. Maybe it's talking with a friend or binge-watching your favorite show. As good as those choices may be, the best comfort of all comes from God. And because of God's comfort towards us, we can be a comfort to others too.

Show Series Graphic: Live Bright

Hi, friends! Today we're looking at a really important idea about how we should treat others from the book of 2 Corinthians. (Hold up Bible.) Second Corinthians is one of the letters in

the New Testament. The leaders of the early church wanted to teach Jesus followers what was true, and they often wrote letters to do that. Second Corinthians is a letter that the apostle Paul wrote to the believers in the church at Corinth. Paul had spent more than a year there, telling people about Jesus. Later, Paul learned that some people in Corinth were speaking against him. In his letter, Paul wrote to encourage the people there to get along . . . and to stay strong through hard times.

It's pretty amazing to think that we can share God's comfort with others. That's a way that we can shine our light and show compassion to the people around us. All of us face tough things. But you can remember that God is there to comfort us and then you can **[bottom line] comfort others the way God comforts you**.

Every person you'll ever meet is someone who needs compassion. Everyone needs to know that someone cares about them. I like how Paul said that ALL comfort comes from God. God is with us when we're hurting. God gives us comfort and compassion. Jesus showed us the very best example of what it looks like to comfort others by the way you treat them. It could be as simple as telling someone that you know they've been having a hard time . . . and that you want them to know they're not alone. You can let them know that God loves them, and you do too. You can let them know you're here for them. That's a great way to show compassion and treat others the way you want to be treated.
