WELCOME

Hi friends! My name is [your name]! I'm so glad you're here! Before we get started with today's lesson, let's review our room rules so that we can have a fun day!

RULES

Show Graphic: Preschool Rules

Let's put on our moose antlers and call our friend Dan-o to help us. (Thumbs on either side of your head with fingers splayed.) Oh Daaaaaannnnn-oooooo! Can you all help me act out our room rules?! (Have kids participate as you do motions.)

- The first rule is: be a friend! (Give yourself a hug as you say the rule.)
- Rule number two is: be safe! (Do baseball gesture for safe.)
- The next rule is: be a good listener! (Cup your ears.)
- Rule number four is: take care of the room and the toys! (Wag your finger while you say the rule.)
- The last rule is: join in! (Spread your arms wide and bring them in.)

WORSHIP

Can anyone tell me what we're celebrating this month? Christmas! That's right! Christmas is about celebrating Jesus because [Bottom Line] Jesus is God's Son. That makes Jesus so very special!

Because we know Jesus is special, we are going to worship Him! Everyone stand up, and let's worship Jesus together!

INTRO

Show Series Graphic: Show & Tell

I can't wait to share a true story from the Bible with you about Christmas!

(Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.)

Today's true story about Christmas begins with Mary and Joseph. They traveled a long way to a town called Bethlehem, and something really special happened when they got to Bethlehem. Ollie and our friends at the Clubhouse are ready to tell us all about it!

APPLICATION

Show Series Graphic: Show & Tell

When Mary and Joseph were in Bethlehem, Jesus was born! Jesus is special because [Bottom Line] Jesus is God's Son. (Ask the kids.) Why is Jesus special? [Bottom Line] Jesus is God's son.

Bible Verse

Show Verse: Isaiah 9:6

(Open Bible.) The Bible teaches us in Isaiah 9:6 that [Memory Verse] God has given a son to us.

Let's learn our **Memory Verse** together. Are you ready? Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me!

"God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down.)
has given (pretend to give a gift.)
a son (rock a baby.)
to us." (point to self twice.)
Isaiah 9:6 (open hands like a book.)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, then have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold hands, and close their eyes.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's take a seat, bow our heads, and close our eyes so that we can pray. (Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold hands, and close their eyes.)

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for the true story of Christmas. Thank You that we get to celebrate that Your Son, Jesus, was born. We love You. In Jesus' name. Amen.

BIG GROUP GAME

Today we learned that Jesus was born in a manger in a stable. A stable is a funny place for a baby to be born, isn't it? What kinds of animals do you think were in the stable the night Jesus was born? (Kids respond.) I bet you're right. Hey! Let's play a game. I'm going to play a sound that you might hear in a stable. Your job is to shout out what animal you think the sound is from. Got it? Good! Let's begin.

Show SFX: Cow

Great guess! Let's see if you're right...

(Repeat until you have played through all sounds and seen all the pictures, or for as long as kids are engaged.)
