### **STORY FOCUS:**

I can trust God no matter what! Elijah trusts God, but it hasn't rained in a really long time and there is no food to eat! God tells Elijah to go to a town and find a woman there who has food for him. Elijah finds the woman, but she only has enough flour and oil left to make bread for her and her son. Elijah tells the woman that God says her flour and oil will not run out. The woman trusts God, no matter what might happen! And just like God said, Elijah, the woman, and her son had food every day because the flour and oil did not run out! Once again, God's got it!

#### WELCOME

Welcome boys and girls! I'm so glad you're here! Before we get started with today's lesson, let's review our room rules so that we can have a fun day!

#### **RULES**

# **Show Graphic: Preschool Rules**

Let's put on our moose antlers and call our friend Dan-o to help us. (Thumbs on either side of your head with fingers splayed.) Oh Daaaaaan-oooooo! Can you all help me act out our room rules?! (Have kids participate as you do motions.)

- The first rule is: be a friend! (Give yourself a hug as you say the rule.)
- Rule number two is: be safe! (Do baseball gesture for safe.)
- The next rule is: be a good listener! (Cup your ears.)
- Rule number four is: take care of the room and the toys! (Wag your finger while you say the rule.)
- The last rule is: join in! (Spread your arms wide and bring them in.)

### **WORSHIP**

Ok, let's all join in now and stand up for worship! Let's do our best singing so we can let God know how much we love Him!

# **Show Series Graphic: Puzzle Pieces**

Wow! No matter how much flour and oil the woman used, she still had more! Just like God said, Elijah, the woman, and her son had food every day! The flour and oil did not run out because [Bottom Line] God's got it. Say it with me! (CHILDREN and LEADERS) [Bottom Line] "God's got it!"

#### **Bible Verse**

#### **Show Verse: Proverbs 3:5**

(Open Bible.) Let's practice our Memory Verse, Proverbs 3:5. Watch me say it with the motions; then you can do it with me! Ready?! Stand up and follow me!

"Trust (Tug a pretend rope.)
in the Lord (Point up.)
with all your heart." (Tap heart twice.)

Proverbs 3:5 (Open hands like a book.)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold hands, and close their eyes.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's take a seat, bow our heads, and close our eyes so that we can pray.

#### **PRAYER**

God, thank You for reminding us how much You care about us through the story of Elijah, the woman, and her son. You took care of what they needed in the same way You take care of all of us. We love You. In Jesus' name. Amen.

#### **BIG GROUP GAME**

Elijah, the woman, and her son all trusted God to care for them. Our bible verse and worship song remind us to trust the Lord with all our hearts too! Let's stand up and sing our worship song one more time!
