## **STORY FOCUS:**

I can talk to God about anything. King Hezekiah loves God, and he prays and talks to God. So, when King Hezekiah is worried about the safety of his city, he prays and talks to God about it. God sends the prophet Isaiah to tell Hezekiah that God has heard Hezekiah's prayer and will keep the city safe! Another time, when Hezekiah is very sick, he goes straight to the One true God, the God he trusts, and prays. Isaiah returns to tell Hezekiah that God says Hezekiah will get better! Hezekiah praises God with singing and music. Hezekiah knew he could talk to God about anything because **God's got it!**

# Preschool Large Group November 2024 Week 4

#### WELCOME

Welcome boys and girls! I'm so glad you're here! Before we get started with today's lesson, let's review our room rules so that we can have a fun day!

#### RULES

#### Show Graphic: Preschool Rules

Let's put on our moose antlers and call our friend Dan-o to help us. (Thumbs on either side of your head with fingers splayed.) Oh Daaaaaan-oooooo! Can you all help me act out our room rules?! (Have kids participate as you do motions.)

- The first rule is: be a friend! (Give yourself a hug as you say the rule.)
- Rule number two is: be safe! (Do baseball gesture for safe.)
- The next rule is: be a good listener! (Cup your ears.)
- Rule number four is: take care of the room and the toys! (Wag your finger while you say the rule.)
- The last rule is: join in! (Spread your arms wide and bring them in.)

#### WORSHIP

Ok! Let's all join in right now and stand up for worship! Let's do our best singing so we can let God know how much we love Him!

Great job, friends! Thanks for worshipping with me today! And now it's time to turn around, sit down, and shake the wiggles out (Wiggle hands.) so we can hear (Cup hands behind ears.) all about our Bible story!

#### INTRO

#### Show Series Graphic: Puzzle Pieces

We've learned something BIG this month! God wants us to trust Him with all our hearts. Because God loves us. He always takes good care of us! **[Bottom Line]** God's got it! Today's true story from the Bible is about a king named Hezekiah who prayed and talked to God. Let's visit our friends at the Clubhouse to hear what King Hezekiah talked to God about!

#### APPLICATION

#### Show Series Graphic: Puzzle Pieces

King Hezekiah talked to God when he was worried and when he was sick. Just like King Hezekiah, we can trust God and talk to God about anything because **[Bottom Line]** God's got it!

#### **Bible Verse**

#### Show Verse: Proverbs 3:5

(Open Bible.) Let's practice our memory verse! Proverbs 3:5. Watch me say it with the motions; then you can do it with me! Ready?! Stand up and follow me!

"Trust (Tug a pretend rope.)
in the Lord (Point up.)
with all your heart." (Tap heart twice.)

Proverbs 3:5 (Open hands like a book.)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold hands, and close their eyes.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's take a seat, bow our heads, and close our eyes so that we can pray.

#### PRAYER

God, we are so thankful that we can talk to You about anything just like King Hezekiah did. You heard Hezekiah then and You hear us now! We love You! In Jesus' name, amen.

#### **BIG GROUP GAME**

King Hezekiah knew he could talk to God about anything, and we can too! Let's do an activity to help us remember to talk to God anytime and about anything! Everyone stand up!

I'll give you an example of something that may happen to us. Show me with your face how you would feel in that situation. Then, we will kneel down to talk to God and shout, **"God's got it!"** Let's practice....

You are sick and can't go to the park. Show me how you would feel (Demonstrate a sad face.) And don't worry if it's something different than me! We all have different feelings! Let's practice talking to God like we would if that happened. (Demonstrate kneeling with hands folded.) Now stand up and shout, "God's got it!" (Kids repeat.)

Great job! Let's keep going... (Repeat with following scenarios. Kids may feel differently than you!)

- You get to go to a birthday party
- You can't find your favorite stuffed animal
- It's raining outside
- You are having pizza for dinner
- Your best friend is coming over to play
- You built a big block tower and someone knocked it over
