GOD VIEW: THE CONNECTION BETWEEN CHRISTMAS AND GOD'S CHARACTER, AS SHOWN THROUGH GOD'S BIG STORY

Music is such a big part of Christmas, but it's not the main reason we celebrate. It's easy to get distracted with all the lights, presents, and traditions that sometimes we forget it's not about the things we do, but Who we do it for and why we do it.

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WEEK 2

What helps you remember that God is with you?

We start with this question to help kids start thinking about all the times that God has been there for them in the past. Focusing on what God has already done instead of their current circumstances makes it a little easier to face new troubles that may come up and helps them to remember that they are not alone!

In week two, we turn to **Luke 1:26-38 and Matthew 1:18-25.** On both occasions, an angel visited Mary and Joseph to inform them that they would be the parents of the coming Savior of the world! They would call Him Immanuel, which means "God with us". They could have said no and refused, but even though they were afraid, they trusted that God would be with them through it all.

Celebrate because God is with you. When God sent Jesus, it was the answer to many, many prayers and a LOT of years of waiting. The people must have wondered what God was doing or if God was still working. We can feel the same way in our own lives. Yet, time and time again, we see that we can trust God no matter what and celebrate because God sent Jesus for us!

GAME TIME

Show Graphic: Puzzlin' Around the Christmas Tree

Christmas songs the best! There are so many Christmas songs out there that you could probably never listen to them all, even if you tried! Even if you had an unlimited Christmas playlist! That just goes to show what a big deal it is that Jesus was born in Bethlehem over 2,000 years ago! Such a big deal that there are like... infinity songs about it!

Today, I have a fun Christmas game planned for you. This one has to do with some of my favorite Christmas songs. I call it: Puzzlin' Around the Christmas Tree.

These puzzles will have some emojis that give hints about the name of a Christmas song. You'll have to figure out what song title is on the screen by decoding the emojis. You'll see what I mean as we play! Talk with your neighbors or leader to try to figure out the answer, but don't shout it out! We want everyone to guess! After a little while, I'll ask what you guys think and you can raise your hand if you think you know the answer! Let's get started!

Great job, everyone! You are all amazing puzzle-solvers! Now let's focus up for our Bible lesson.

Show Series Graphic: Christmas Playlist

Christmas is SUCH a fun time of year, and all the joy and celebration is about Jesus! We celebrate because at Christmas, Jesus was born to be our Savior! Jesus is God's greatest gift to us, and He's the best gift we could ever receive!

(Hold up Bible) We can find our story today in two of the Gospels: Matthew and Luke. Remeber, the Gospels are the four books at the start of the New Testament-- Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John-- that tell us about Jesus' life. Let's check out our Bible story video to learn more!

Mary and Joseph's lives were about to change in a way they could never have imagined. But they both had peace because they knew that God was with them! God had chosen them to take care of the Savior, Jesus, so Mary and Joseph welcomed baby Jesus into the world! Here's what we need to remember today:

[BOTTOM LINE] Celebrate because God is with you. Say that with me! Celebrate because God is with you.

Even when things happen that we don't expect, we can have peace because we know that God is with us, and we can trust God no matter what! There are so many fun ways to celebrate Christmas, but the reason we celebrate is the same reason Mary and Joseph could celebrate way back then-- because of Jesus!

Christmas is about celebrating Jesus, God's greatest gift! Let's remember this by practicing our **Memory Verse** for this month. It is Matthew 1:21 (NIrV). Let's say it together:

Show Verse: Matthew 1:21 (NIrV)

"Mary is going to have a son. You must give him the name Jesus. That's because he will save the people from their sins." Matthew 1:21 (NIrV)

God sent Jesus FOR us, and God is always WITH us! When we choose to follow Jesus and discover more about Him, we can be friends with Him! We can know that God is always with us, and that can give us true peace no matter what's going on in our lives! When you know Jesus, you can always have peace. That's a big reason to celebrate!

Show Graphic: WK2_Key Question

As you go to your groups today, think about this: **"What helps you remember that God is with you?**

Think about times when you have been tempted to believe that God wasn't with you. Then think about you were able to remember that God is with you. You might have trouble thinking about a specific moment, and that's okay. You'll have a chance to chat about this with your group. They might be able to help you! Now, before you head to groups, let's pray and thank God for, Jesus who always reminds us that God is with us!

PRAYER

God, thank You for the way You showed Mary and Joseph that You were with them. Thank You for the way You chose them to welcome Jesus, our Savior, to the world. And God, thank You for reminding us today that You're always with US too. When things happen that we don't expect, or that seem confusing, help us to trust You and remember that You are always with us. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen!
