God, we pray for our friends at Uncharted and for all our Friends Around the World. We pray that you would help them with all the work they are doing for you and thank you for letting us be a part of it by giving money and praying. We love you, and it's in Jesus' name that we pray. Amen!

Can you believe it? We're SO close to Christmas! I love this time of year, because . . . well, I love Christmas music. I love a good Christmas playlist! And most of all, I love celebrating Jesus' birth with the people I love. My family loves to bake a 'Happy Birthday Jesus' cake, and we all give each other gifts by our Christmas tree. Gifts are always a big part of our celebration! That makes sense because Jesus Himself is the greatest gift we could ever receive. And really, all good things in life are gifts from God!

Mary's and Joseph's lives were about to change in a way they could never have imagined. But they both had peace because they knew that God was with them. Not only were their lives about to change, but all of our lives changed! That's why other people, like the shepherds, were celebrating too! And they told others so they could celebrate with them! Here's what we need to remember today:

[Bottom line] Celebrate Jesus with others. Say that with me! Celebrate Jesus with others!

It's pretty cool to think that Mary and Joseph were the very first ones to get to celebrate Jesus. Because of the incredible news they'd heard from the angel, they knew that within just a few months, they would literally be holding God's own Son in their arms! There are so many fun ways to celebrate Christmas. And the reason we celebrate is the same reason Mary and Joseph could celebrate way back then. Christmas is about celebrating Jesus, God's greatest gift!

Let's remember this by practicing our **Memory Verse** for this month. It's Matthew 1:21 (NIrV). Let's say it together:

As you go to your groups today, think about this: **How are you celebrating Christmas this** year?

Talk about what it looks like to celebrate Jesus in a way that we can share the good news about Him with others. I bet your Small Group can come up with some amazing ideas! Before you head to groups, let's pray and thank God for Jesus.
