How do you feel when you give? Have you ever noticed how excited some people get when they watch others open gifts? The gift isn't even for them, and yet they can't wait to see someone they care about receive something they'll enjoy! Our hope for this question is that preteens will stop and think not only about why being generous is important but also how important our attitude can be when we give. In week 3, we take a look at Paul's words in 2 Corinthians 9:7. Paul was writing to the church in Corinth, encouraging them to give. When we give, it pleases God—not just because of what we give, but because of the way we give it. When we give with a good attitude, we can help others see what God is like.

Give with a good attitude. Have you ever shared something really nice with someone, but you didn't do it with the best intentions? Maybe, if you were honest, you really didn't want to share what you had in the first place. Our attitude makes a big difference when we give. It doesn't matter what kind of gift you give if your heart isn't in the right place. As Paul explained, God loves it when we give cheerfully!

When you give with a good attitude, others can see God at work! God is the ultimate Giver . . . so when we share what we have, we reflect a little bit of Who God is to the world around us.

So once you've made up your mind to give your time or your stuff, don't focus on what you're giving up. Instead, focus on how you're making the other person feel. Think about how God can use what you've given in a big way. THAT'S how we can give with a good attitude! Here's what we need to remember today:

[BOTTOM LINE] Give with a good attitude. Say that with me. Give with a good attitude.

When we're tempted to keep what we have . . . or to have a bad attitude when we give . . . we should remember that everything we DO have comes from God. Then we'll be willing to give it back to help someone else. Jesus was the best Giver of all of us. He showed generosity to everyone!

Show Graphic: Virtue

Generosity is about making someone's day by giving something away.

Memory Verse:

Let's remember this by practicing our Memory Verse for this month. It is James 1:17a (NIrV). Let's say it together:

Show Verse: James 1:17a (NIrV)

"Every good and perfect gift is from God." James 1:17a (NIrV)

We can never run out of ways to give with a good attitude! Exactly. And that's a great way to treat others the way we want to be treated. Let's pray and ask God to help us give cheerfully.

Show Graphic: WK3_Key Question

"As you go to your groups today, think about this: "**How do you feel when you give?"** Think about a specific time you can remember giving. What was your attitude like? How might you learn from Paul and have a cheerful attitude next time? If you have trouble thinking through a specific moment in your life, that's okay! You'll have a chance to chat with your group all about this and hear from them. That's one of the great things about Small

Group—you all get to learn what it means to follow Jesus together! Before you go, let's pray and ask God to help us give to others with cheerful hearts!

PRAYER

God, thank You for this reminder You've given us today from Paul's letter to the Corinthians. We want to do what Paul taught—to give with a good attitude and a cheerful heart! We want to make up our minds to give and trust that You can do a lot with what we give. Please help us to show Your love to others by giving what we have. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
