OPENER 3 minutes

(Welcome kids.)

Hello, my friends! You're here, I'm here, and it's a great day here at Flatirons Kids! This month we're talking about how God is with us through all the different seasons of our lives. And I don't just mean seasons like winter, spring, summer, and fall. I mean that God is with us when things are good... and God is with us when we face challenges too. God is there to help us when we feel sad, when we feel scared or worried, when we feel angry, AND when we feel happy! God helps us to be strong no matter what we're feeling.

GAME TIME

So far this month, we've done a spring game, a summer game, and a fall game. Today? It's all about the winter!

SHOW SLIDE: "SNOWBALL SCOOP"

The name of our game today is **Snowball Scoop!** Let's get two contestants! Raise your hand if you want to play!

(Pick two kids from each side to go on stage. Be sure to pick kids from different parts of the room— not just up front. The two large bowls should be on the floor with cotton balls spread out between them.)

Here's how 'Snowball Scoop' works. Each team has a bowl and spoon in front of them. The floor is full of weightless, fluffy (Air quotes.) "snowballs." (Hold up one of the cotton balls.) When I say "Go," each contestant will use a spoon to scoop as many snowballs as they can into their empty bowl—and they must do this while blindfolded! Keep in mind, these snowballs are almost weightless, so this will be really tough for our contestants. It'll be hard to tell whether the spoon is really full or not! Whichever team gets the most snowballs in their bowl in one-minute wins!

(Give each contestant a blindfold to put on. It would be easiest if these could be sleep-mask style. Make sure they can't see. Then give each of them a large mixing spoon.)

Okay, I think we're ready! Be sure to cheer for your teammates, everyone. Alright contestant... ready... set... go!

Show countdown: 60-seconds

(Encourage the audience to cheer for their teammates. When time's up, count the cotton balls and declare the winning team. Thank all contestants, collect their game supplies, and dismiss them to their seats.)

Wow! What an epic game! I'm so impressed with our contestants. They didn't give up, even when they couldn't tell whether what they were doing was working or not! Thanks kids!

WORSHIP 6-7 minutes

Let's get ready to worship God together now! Worship helps us focus our hearts on God's great love for us. As we sing, we remember what really matters and how good God is to us. When we worship God, it's a way we can choose joy. We can remember that God is good, that God loves us, and that God is always with us. Let's stand and get ready to sing!

(Encourage kids to worship God through song and dance. Play worship songs.)

INTRO 1 minute

Show Series Graphic: Rise and Shine

Today we get to talk about at a really fun emotion: JOY. We have a story coming up about some guys who chose joy even in a tough situation.

Today we're looking at a story from the book of Acts. (Hold up Bible.) This part of the Bible talks about the early days of the church . . . after Jesus died, came back to life, and then went back to heaven. In the book of Acts, we can read about people like Paul, who shared the good news about Jesus in all kinds of different places. Paul and his friends traveled around, starting churches and teaching people about the amazing things Jesus had done. Let's check out our story!

Show Series Graphic: Rise and Shine

Even though Paul and Silas had been treated unfairly-- lied about, hurt, and thrown in prison-- they chose to look to God and trust God to give them joy. In the middle of their darkest and scariest moments, they chose to worship God with joyful hearts. Here's what we need to remember today:

Show Graphic: WK4_Bottom Line

[Bottom line] God can help you choose joy. Say that with me. God can help you choose joy.

I can't imagine what the other prisoners were thinking when they saw all the joy Paul and Silas had, even when they were chained up and in jail! It's pretty amazing to think about! But the truth is, God can give us joy-- even in hard times. We can trust God in every season, rain or shine. And that's how we can find resilience.

Show Graphic: Virtue

Resilience means getting back up when something gets you down.

There's a big difference between happiness and joy. It's easy to feel happy when everything goes right in your life. Joy is something deeper and more real. We can find joy when we look to God and trust Him no matter what, no matter what we are going through. We can find joy even if our troubles don't go away right away, because we know that God has promised to make everything right in the end for those who follow Jesus!

Let's remember this by practicing our **Memory Verse** for this month. It is Psalm 31:24 (NIrV). Let's say it together:

Show Verse: Psalm 31:24 (NIrV)

"Be strong, all you who put your hope in the Lord. Never give up." Psalm 31:24 (NIrV)

So, because we trust God, we can choose joy! We can remember that God loves us, God is with us, and God is there to help us. Let's go ahead and talk to God about that right now!

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for the joy You give us each day. Thank You for giving us a reason to always have joy because we have You in our lives. When we go through things that are challenging or confusing, help us to remember Your love for us. Give us the strength and **resilience** to be able to trust You, even when life is hard. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
