
GOD VIEW:

Upper Elementary- Large Group FEBRUARY 2025 WEEK 2

Key Question: What's unique about you? Have you ever heard the phrase, "There's something different about you," and weren't quite sure how to take that? Is that a good thing or...Sometimes being different and unique might seem like a bad thing, but God has created each and every one of us uniquely and for good. Our hope is that this question opens preteens up to love the unique ways God created them.

In week 2, we head to **Exodus 3–4:15** for the story of Moses. Moses had been through a LOT in his life. He was born as an Israelite but raised in the Egyptian Pharoah's household, and when he grew older, Moses sinned and ran away from his home. Yet God saw Moses and had created him for more than he could ever imagine. Even though Moses didn't see how special he was, God used Moses to make a difference in the lives of so many people.

Bottom Line: God made you to make a difference. Is there something you've always wanted to do but were too scared to do because you thought either someone else was better at it or that you weren't good enough? Sometimes our fears can get in the way of the good God wants to do through us, but God has called us for so much more. We can make a difference because that's how God created us.



OPENER 3 minutes

(Welcome kids)

Show Series Graphic: Made

Today's story comes from the second book of the Bible—Exodus. (Hold up Bible.) "When we look back to the very beginning, we see how God made a beautiful world. But when people turned away from God, the world was broken. Still, God had a plan to rescue people and restore us to relationship. God chose one family, which became the Israelite people. God promised that the entire world would be blessed through them. "In the book of Exodus, we read how the Israelites were enslaved in Egypt for a long, long time. It was really difficult, and they cried out to God for help. Let's check out today's story!

God had given Moses a unique story and purpose. God had chosen Moses to confront Pharaoh and lead the Israelites out of Egypt. God made Moses to make a difference! Did you know that that's true for you too? Here's what we need to remember:

Show Graphic: WK2_Bottom Line

[BOTTOM LINE] God made you to make a difference. Say that with me. **God made you to make a difference.**

Everything that happened to Moses, good and bad, helped make him ready to make a difference. He wasn't perfect, but he changed history. When God wants you to make a difference, God will make a way for that to happen. Just think about the unique way God made you.

Uniqueness is learning more about yourself so you can make a difference.

God uniquely made each of us. David wrote about that in Psalm 139:14, which is our Memory Verse for this month.

Sometimes it's your unique story and the things you've experienced in life that can help you make a difference. Like if you've ever had a time when you were the new kid at school or on the team, you know what that's like. Your experience can help you know how to better help someone else when THEY'RE the new kid. remember, when we follow Jesus, God sends the Holy Spirit to live inside us and help us. We can always rely on God's power and wisdom and creativity to help us make a difference.

Show Slide: WK 2 KEY QUESTION

As you go to your groups today, think about this: **"What's unique about you?"** Maybe it's the way you see and think about the world. Maybe it's the way you dance, play an instrument, or kick a soccer ball. Maybe it's the experiences you have had in your life this far. Whatever it might be, we all have something unique about each one of us! That's because we're made in God's image. But remember, if you're having trouble figuring out the way you're unique, don't worry. You have plenty of time to figure that out. Maybe you can even chat about that with your Small Group. They might be able to help you discover something new about yourself. Before we head to groups, let's pray and thank God for making us all so unique. Let's ask God to help us use those unique gifts to make a difference. Let's pray.

Dear God, thank You for the way You've made us. Thank You for giving each of us a special purpose. We can see how You used Moses' uniqueness in a big way as he led Your people out of Egypt.
