

#### WEEK 3

**Key Question: What are your gifts?** Has anyone ever told you that you were really good at something? Maybe it was a sport or the way you solve problems. Our prayer is that preteens will begin to explore the different gifts and talents they have and how they can use them to help others.

In week 3, we head to **Acts 16:13-15**, where we find a successful businesswoman named Lydia. On Paul's second journey, he headed to Philippi where he found Lydia and a group of women gathered together to pray. Paul shared the news of Jesus with Lydia, and she used her gifts to serve the believers.

**Bottom Line: Use your gifts to make a difference.** Can you sing or dance? Maybe you are great at encouraging others or helping them with their homework. Everyone has something they can offer or contribute to this world that helps someone else, whether it's a big gift or a small one. So how can you use your gifts to impact someone else today?



**OPENER 3 minutes** 

(Welcome kids)

Today we're taking a look at an important idea from the book of James. (Hold up Bible.) This book of the Bible was written by Jesus' half-brother, James! Think about that. James came to believe that his brother was the Son of God... and he wanted to help others put their faith in Jesus too. Let's check out our story!

Lydia continued to offer everything she had to serve the new church in her city, even when Paul and his friends left to continue their journey. She used the gifts and talents that God had given her to help others. And you know what? That's something you can do too. Here's what we need to remember today:

[BOTTOM LINE] Use your gifts to make a difference. Say that with me. Use your gifts to make a difference.

God works in our lives when we put our faith in Jesus. Every person is made by God with something unique to offer!

#### **Show Graphic: Virtue**

Remember, Uniqueness is learning more about yourself so you can make a difference.

God made you with your own unique skills, talents, and personality. With God's help, there are lots of ways that you can use those things to make a difference for others.

Our Memory Verse for this month will help us remember this. It is Psalm 136:14 (NIrV). Let's say it together:

"How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well." Psalm 136:14 (NIrV)

**Show Slide: WK 3 KEY QUESTION** 

As you go to your groups today, think about this: "What are your gifts?" Think about how God created you. Think about your unique skills and talents. Think about what you just enjoy doing. Then consider how can you use what you have RIGHT NOW to make a difference. How can you love God and serve others through the gifts God has given you? If you're not quite sure, that's totally fine, too. We're still growing and figuring out how God has wired us. You can also talk to people like a family member, a teacher, or your Small Group Leader to help you discover some of this, too! Speaking of Small Group, before we head out, let's pray and thank God for creating us so uniquely to help those around us. Let's pray.

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#### **PRAYER**

Dear God, thank You for the way the stories in the Bible teach us how to live. Thank You for the example we heard today—of how Lydia used the gifts You gave her to make a difference for the believers in her town. Please help us to discover the unique gifts and talents You've given each of us. And please show us how we can use those gifts to make a difference for the people around us. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
