“TRIVIA QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS”

- What is the name of the man who was the main character in today's story? (*Nehemiah*)
- What was the name of the king that Nehemiah worked for? (*King Artaxerxes*)
- What was Nehemiah's job? (*He was the drink taster for the king.*)
- Who came to visit Nehemiah in Persia? (*His brother, Hanani*)
- What concerning news did Hanani have to share with Nehemiah? (*The Israelites were having a hard time, and the city wall had been broken down.*)
- What was Nehemiah's initial response to the news about his people? (*He wept and was so upset that he couldn't eat. He cried out to God, asking for help in talking to the king.*)
- What did Nehemiah do after he prayed? (*He went to talk to King Artaxerxes to ask for permission to go to Jerusalem to help rebuild the wall.*)
- Why was it a big deal what Nehemiah asked of the king? (*He was only a servant, so it took boldness to ask to leave for such a long time.*)
- How did King Artaxerxes respond to Nehemiah's request? (*He granted his request and even offered to send supplies and people help.*)
- How long did it take for Nehemiah and his men to arrive in Jerusalem? (*It likely took months of travel.*)
- What did Nehemiah do once he was able to see all the devastation? (*He spoke to the people and began rallying them to work together to rebuild the wall.*)
- Why was the job to rebuild the wall especially difficult? (*They faced opposition from neighboring areas. Also, there were so many things that needed repairing, and not many people who were skilled in building.*)
- What were the names of the officials from neighboring areas who opposed Nehemiah? (*Sanballat and Tobiah*)
- What was Nehemiah's strategy for handling the huge job? (*He assigned different groups and families to be responsible for different sections of the wall.*)
- How did Sanballat and Tobiah respond to Nehemiah's success in rebuilding the wall? (*They mocked him, and planned to attack Jerusalem before the wall was finished.*)
- How did Nehemiah respond when he heard there would be an attack? (*He reminded the Israelites that God was with them, and he assigned people to different tasks, such as standing guard or continuing to rebuild the wall.*)
- Once the wall was finally finished, what did Nehemiah and the people do? (*They thanked and honored God, and they celebrated!*)
- What is our Bottom Line from today's story? (*Work together to solve problems.*)
