Key Question:

What part can you play? The preteen years are the perfect time for kids to explore their role in the church — and we all have a role we can play! We hope to give preteens the chance to figure out how God has uniquely gifted them to help point their friends and family to Jesus.

We end the month in **1 Corinthians 12:12-27** with the early church. Arguments had broken out and sides were taken as the believers struggled to come together. Paul wrote to them, encouraging them to use their differences as they work together to tell others about Jesus because their gifts work best together.

Bottom Line:

Work together to point people to Jesus. When we work together, many people will have a chance to see Jesus' love in action. Accomplishing Jesus' mission for the world is a HUGE undertaking. However, when we practice working together, we can help others and show them Jesus along the way.

In this book, the people in the early church started getting have some issues and Paul is writing this letter to them to remind them of what we have been talking about all month... they need to work together! As followers of Jesus, we have an amazing job to do together. We can show people what Jesus is like and help them understand how much He loves each and every one of us. When we cooperate, we can be like one body -- the body of Christ – all working together!

Here's what we need to remember:

Show Graphic: WK5_Bottom Line

[Bottom line] Work together to point people to Jesus.

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

God made each of us unique so that when we work together, we can show a clear picture of what Jesus is like to the world around us. That takes a lot of cooperation!

Show Graphic: Virtue

Cooperation is about working together to do more than you can do alone.

You might not be sure about working with others because you feel like you don't have a lot to offer. Or you may feel like you're really good at something and don't need help from others. But the truth is, your particular gifts are needed and valuable and you need other people because of their unique gifts too! We need each other, just like we need all the different parts of our body. It takes all of us together to point people to Jesus.

Maybe you have an older neighbor who can't get around. Your family could get different people in the neighborhood to help in different ways. Like bringing a meal or taking care of the yard or just sitting with them and praying for them.

Let's remember this by practicing our *[Memory Verse]* for this month. It is Ecclesiastes 4:9 (NIrV). Let's say it together:

Show Verse: Ecclesiastes 4:9 (NIrV)

"Two people are better than one. They can help each other in everything they do." Ecclesiastes 4:9 (NIrV)

Think about the way our church comes together. We need everyone from our pastor to our preschool teachers. Every person here plays a part as we try our best to point people to Jesus!

As you go to your groups today, think about this: **"How can helping people point them to Jesus?"** How can you use your words, the way you love others, and the wise choices you make with your life to point others to Jesus? And if you're not sure what that looks like for you, don't worry. You'll have a chance to chat all about this with your small group. Before you head out, how about we pray and thank God for inviting us and giving us a chance to make a difference right now? Let's pray.

Dear God, thank You for creating us to live in community. We know that **[Basic Truth]** we can trust You no matter what, and that You made us to work together. We want to cooperate and work together to do more than any of us could do alone. We want to do that well so that our lives can point people to Jesus. Please give us the wisdom, patience, and love to work together in Your Name and shine Your light in this world. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
