











Jerusalem:

"Why was Saul going to Damascus? Act it out as a group."

"What did Barnabas do to help Saul? Show it as a group in a freeze-frame pose!" Answer: Barnabas took Saul to the Jesus-followers himself and told them all about Saul's journey. The believers finally accepted Saul as one of their own!

Tarsus:

"Saul's new friends helped him return to his hometown of Tarsus, where he would be safe. What is one way your team can live in peace with others? Share your ideas."

Answer: Kids might say: taking turns playing a game instead of arguing, using kind words instead of being bossy, if we see someone playing alone, we can ask them to play, etc.
