### OPENER

(Welcome kids)

Friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! My name is (your name), and it's my favorite time of the week because we are learning about Jesus! **[Bottom Line]** Jesus shows me how to love others.

When I ask, "Who shows you how to love others?" I want you to say, **[Bottom Line]** "Jesus shows me how to love others."

(Ask the group) "Who shows you how to love others?"

(Kids and leaders respond) **[Bottom Line]** "Jesus shows me how to love others."

### WORSHIP

Yes! **[Bottom Line]** "Jesus shows me how to love others." Let's sing about that! Everyone stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

### INTRO

## APPLICATION

**Show Series Graphic: Live It Out**

## Bible Verse

**Show Verse: Philippians 2:5**

(Open Bible) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. The Bible teaches us in Philippians 2:5, **"Think and act as Jesus did."**

Let's learn this **[Memory Verse]** together! Everyone stand up! Are you ready? Watch me say it and do the motions; then you can do it with me!

**Think** (point to head)

**And act** (walk in place)

**As Jesus did** (tap finger to middle of each palm)

**Philippians 2:5** (open hands like a book)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

## PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to show us how to love others. Please help us love like Jesus and make peace. You're the best, God! In Jesus' name. Amen.
