WEDNESDAY: TIE DYE TOTE BAGS

WHAT YOU NEED:

- “Tie-Dye Finishing Steps” Activity Page; prepared white tote bags; rubber bands; disposable plastic gloves; scissors; paper towels; plastic tablecloths; prepared squirt bottles; disposable pans; clear tape

WHAT YOU DO:

- Cover the tables with plastic tablecloths. Set a tote bag in a disposable pan at each kid’s spot.
- Give each kid a pair of gloves to wear. Encourage the kids to carefully squirt one color of dye onto each section of their item. Remind them to make sure the dye is squirted into all the folds to cover every white surface.
- Before they move to the next color, tell kids to use the paper towels to wipe off their gloves. Encourage them to share all the colors so every friend has a turn with all the colors.
- Once kids are done applying the dye, have them set their item on a couple of paper towels to absorb excess dye.
- Write each kid’s name on a zip-top bag and place that kid’s tie-dyed item in the bag.
- Tape a “Tie-Dye Finishing Steps” Activity Page to each bag.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- “Look how colorful your creations are! I can’t wait for you to see the finished result. When you use these items, it can serve as a reminder to thank God for what he’s done for us. Jesus came to give His life for us so we can be forgiven. We don’t deserve His forgiveness, and still He offers it to us. Why? Because He loves us! When we’re hurt or frustrated and we just want to stay mad at someone, let’s remember we’ve been forgiven. Let’s ask God to help us forgive one another as we love one another.”
