# **MONDAY: TEAM FLAG + PERSONAL PENNANTS**

## **WHAT YOU NEED:**

- Large Team Flag, Personal Pennant Flags, Flag Poles, Paint Pens, Fabric Glue, Felt Shapes, Glitter Glue, Stickers

## **WHAT YOU DO:**

- Lay out a large team flag. Set the paint pens, fabric glue, stickers, felt shapes and glitter glue on the table.
- If your group has a team name, write it in large block letters in the center of your Flag.
- Have the children gather around the table and decorate your team banner with the paint pens and glitter glue provided. Inside the letters, you can use a sharpie to draw in shapes or lines to create different patterns kids can color in to add interest.
- Encourage kids to sign their name around the edge of the banner.
- Guide kids to each make a personal flag:
  - Place a personal pennant flag at each spot at the table.
  - Encourage kids to write your team name and their own name on their flag and encourage them to decorate it any way they choose. Remind them to draw out their design first with a pencil and then outline it with the sharpie marker.

## **WHAT YOU SAY:**

- “Our team banner and your flags look awesome! Great job, friends. We can carry these with us today as a reminder to show our team spirit. We’re learning this week that we can live out our faith and show others how much God loves them. Jesus showed us how to love one another. We can follow Jesus’ example and show love to others, too.”
