# **TUESDAY: LAVA LAMP + PRAYER JOURNALS**

## **WHAT YOU NEED:**

- Plastic bottles; food coloring; vegetable oil; alka-seltzer tablets; spoon; prayer journals

## **WHAT YOU DO (LAMP LAMPS):**

- Fill the container: Fill the container about 1/4 to 1/3 full with water.
- Add food coloring: Add a few drops of food coloring to the water and stir to mix.
- Pour in the oil: Carefully pour in vegetable oil until the container is nearly full, leaving a small space at the top. Observe how the oil floats on top of the water.
- Drop in the tablets: Break an Alka-Seltzer tablet into pieces and drop them into the container one at a time.
- Watch the reaction: As the tablets react with the water, you'll see the colored water start to bubble and move up and down, creating the lava lamp effect.
- Repeat the fun: You can add more Alka-Seltzer tablets to keep the lava lamp going.
- Safety Tip: Do not put a lid on the container while it's active, as the gas from the tablets can build up pressure.

## **WHAT YOU DO (PRAYER JOURNALS):**

- Give each child a blank prayer journal
- Lay out paint pens and glitter glue on the table
- Instruct kids to decorate the cover of their prayer journals
- Demonstrate how to Pray in Color
