YOUR ROLE AS A SMALL GROUP LEADER

BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH YOUR FEW

The best way for kids to know God is to know someone who knows God. Get to know your kids and have them get to know you! Encourage and find ways for kids to connect with one another. The goal is for each child to be seen and known by a leader.

KEEP TRACK OF YOUR FEW

Count the kids in your small group before you move to the next activity and once you get to the activity.

BE PRESENT + BE AN EXAMPLE

Be fully engaged, and model participation and excitement. Cell phones need to be put away for the entire duration of Kids Camp.

BE PREPARED

Talk about the theme for each day, the week's verse, ask questions about the Bible story, learn the kids names, connect with your kids, have games to play and affirm your kids. Carry your provided backpack with supplies needed for the day.

GIVE EXPECTATIONS + PLACE BOUNDARIES

Remind kids of the right behavior: to be kind and respectful. Affirm your kids and redirect misbehavior.

SPIRITUALLY LEAD YOUR FEW

Kids Camp leaders are expected to live a lifestyle that is in obedience to the Bible and are a model to the kids and families of Flatirons. Pray for and with your kids, know and encourage your kids, + learn + discuss the Bible's bottom lines and stories together.

HAVE FUN!

Enjoy your group and have a great week with them! Fill the transition time with games, conversation and things that build community. Do fun things to bring identity and FUN to your group!
