



WEEK ONE – AUGUST 2025 – TODDLERS

Bible Story: *Creation | Genesis 1:3-2:3*

Key Question: *Who made everything?*

Bottom Line: *God made everything*

Memory Verse: *“God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.
(Genesis 1:31, NIrV)*

Basic Truth: *God made me.*

Series Overview: This month, we are taking our preschoolers on an exciting journey to the moon and back as we teach them that God made everything. We want our preschoolers to know that this beautiful world they live in was created by our loving, creative, and powerful God. All God had to do was say it, and it was! Wow! So, what did God do after He made everything? *“God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.” (Genesis 1:31 NIrV)* Then, God rested. And that is what we hope to do this month with our preschoolers. Look at everything God made. See that it is very good. And then rest in knowing that our God is powerful and creative and beautiful, and He loves us to the moon and back.

LARGE GROUP

Story Time

Gather children at the tables to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need: Preschool Bible

What You Say:

“Hello, friends! I’m so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today’s true story from the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) begins when there was nothing. No people, no animals, no land, no ocean, no sun . . . but God was there. Then God made the heavens and the whole, wide world!

“On Day 1, (*hold up one finger*) God said, ‘*Let there be light!*’ (*Genesis 1:3, NIV*). And there was light. God called the light ‘day’ and the dark ‘night.’ On Day 2, (*hold up two fingers*) God put some water way down low and the sky way up high. On Day 3, (*hold up three fingers*) God made all the land, seas, and plants with fruits and vegetables for us to eat. Then, on Day 4, (*hold up four fingers*) God made the sun to light the day, and the moon and stars to light the night. But God wasn’t finished yet!

“On Day 5, (*hold up five fingers*) God made all the sea animals and the birds that fly in the sky. Then on Day 6, (*hold up six fingers*) God made the land animals and God’s most special creation of all—people! God looked at all God had made and saw that it was very good! (*Give two thumbs-up.*) Then God rested. [**Bottom Line**] **God made everything.** And it was very good.”

SMALL GROUP

Craft Time

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time.

Depending on the size of your group, you may lead the craft two or three times.

Not every child may want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their mom or dad.

What You Need: “Rocket Handprint” Activity Page; red or orange washable ink pads; baby wipes; permanent marker

What You Do:

- Write each child's name on their paper.
- Help children press and cover their hand with the ink, and press it at the base of the rocket for the flare.
 - Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

*“Look! There's a rocket on your paper! It's flying high up in the air. Let's give the rocket some blast off flare with your handprint! We need to cover your whole hand with the ink from the ink pad, then press it right here at the bottom of your rocket. (Pause.) Say: 'Blast off!' (Repeat with children. Clean hands.) Your rocket looks super-cool! It's blasting off and traveling to see all the amazing things God made because **[Bottom Line] God made everything!**”*
