




What to Do:
Print on paper, one superhero for every kid.




1. Fold in Half

Take your paper and fold it lengthwise. (hotdog style)
Unfold it so you have a crease in the middle.




2. Fold the Top Corners

Fold the top-left corner down to the center crease.
Fold the top-right corner down to the center crease.
This should create a triangle shape at the top.



3. Fold the Top Again

Take the new edges you just created and fold them
down to the center crease again. This makes the
airplane's nose sharper.




4. Fold in Half

Fold the entire paper in half along the original
crease, keeping the folds on the outside.



5. Create the Wings

Fold one side down, about an inch from the
bottom edge. Flip the airplane over and fold the
other wing down to match.



6. Adjust and Fly!

Hold the plane at the bottom and gently throw it forward.
Adjust the wings slightly if needed for a better flight.

1. Who were Isaac and Rebekah's children?

(Answer: Esau, Jacob)

7. Where did Rebekah tell Jacob to go after Esau got angry?

(Answer: Rebekah told Jacob to go to her brother Laban and stay there until Esau calmed down.)

8. What happened when Jacob was alone in the wilderness?

(Answer: Jacob had a dream about a stairway to heaven with angels going up and down, and God standing next to the stairway.)

9. God made several promises to Jacob in Jacob's dream. What were some of those promises that God made to Jacob?


(Possible answers: God promised to give Jacob and his children the land Jacob was on, God promised that Jacob would have lots of children, God promised that all nations would be blessed through them. God also promised to be with Jacob, to watch over him, and to bring him back to the land he was on.)

10. What did Jacob do in response to God's promise?

(Possible answers: Jacob made a promise to God, he set up the stone he was sleeping on as a sacred stone, he poured out oil on the stone he had been sleeping on, he called the place "Bethel," and he promised that God would be his God.)

"JACOB'S LADDER"

1. Lay the 1" wide strips perpendicular to each other and overlap at one end.
2. Then, tape the ends together.
3. Take the strip at the rear and fold it over the front strip.
4. Then take the second strip and fold it forward over the first.
5. Continue folding until both strips are folded (see the illustration).



6. To finish the chain, tape the ends together.
7. Pull the ends to open the ladder.
