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## OPENER

(Welcome kids)

Hi friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! "Hi, friends! My name is [Your Name], and I'm SO excited to see you! We're going to worship and celebrate God together. We can celebrate God because God made you (point to kids) and [BASIC TRUTH] God made me. (point to kids) Say that with me!

**"God made me!"**

(Kids and leaders respond) [Basic truth] "God made me!"

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## WORSHIP

Yes! [Basic truth] "God made me!" Now, let's celebrate God! Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

**Show Worship: King of the Jungle**

Thanks for worshipping with me today! You can sit right down.

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## BIG GROUP GAME

Let's play a game! Okay, here is what we're going to do. I'm going to show you some drawing videos. I want you to guess what animal is being drawn before the video ends. Ready?

That was so fun! Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands) so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!

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## APPLICATION

Show Series Graphic: To the Moon and Back

Wow! God made every single person! And God didn't make all people the same. God made everyone special and unique. Now when you look around at the great big world and see animals and people, you can say, 'Wow! **[Bottom Line] God made everything!**'

(Ask the group) "Who made everything?"

(Kids and leaders respond) **[Bottom Line] "God made everything."**

Yes! **[Bottom Line] "God made everything."**

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## Bible Verse

(Open Bible) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. The Bible teaches us in Genesis 1:31, "**God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.**"

Let's learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Video: Memory Verse Motions

Show Verse: Genesis 1:31

God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down)

Saw everything he had made. (Binocular eyes.)

And it was very good, (two thumbs-up)

Genesis 1:31 (open hands like a book)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)
