



This month kicks off our year-long journey through the Bible as we look at God’s Big Story. Every story has a beginning. As we explore Creation, the Fall and other pivotal moments in the origin of our faith, kids will discover that not only did God create everything, but even after people chose to go their own way, God had a plan to restore us.

We can see how God faithfully began to fulfill that plan in Abram’s call and in the lives of Jacob and Joseph—and we look forward to the fulfillment of that plan in Jesus. When kids see how God has worked in the past, they can grow in faith that our faithful God continues to work in and through each person who chooses to follow Jesus.

In the origin stories of our faith, we discover that God loves us more deeply than we can imagine. From the beginning, God had a plan to restore us to relationship with Him by sending Jesus. And because God fulfilled that promise, we can trust God with our whole lives.

Faith: Trusting in what you can't see because of what you can see



About Faith All month, we're doing a deep dive into the origins of our faith! Kids are concrete thinkers, and while faith comes easily to some, others struggle to believe in a God they can't see with their own eyes. That's why it's so important to help kids understand that faith in God isn't a "blind leap."

We may not be able to see God with our physical eyes, but we can see the countless things that God has done and the promises that God has fulfilled. This is true for the stories from Genesis we'll cover this month, but it's also true in the lives of Jesus followers over the last two thousand years—and in your own life.

Make It Personal

This is a great month for you to share a personal, age-appropriate story of something God has done in your life, and how your own faith grew as a result.

You can also remind kids that faith is not something we have to work up to on our own. Paul wrote in Romans 10:17 that *"faith comes from hearing the message. And the message that is heard is the message about Christ" (NirV).*

The more that we hear about God's deep love for us in His Word, the Bible, and about the things that Jesus said and did, the stronger our faith becomes. Our faith also grows when we live out the things we have learned. In fact, Hebrews records that Jesus is the Author and Perfecter of our faith. Encourage kids that they can ask God to grow their faith—and trust that He will do it.

Show Series Theme Graphic: Origin Story

Hey kids! I am really excited you guys are here at Flatirons Kids this month because it's going to be EPIC!

Who likes superhero movies? I love seeing these superhero characters showing off their moves and saving the world! But you know, a lot of them didn't just wake up and become crimefighters. They had an origin story or a beginning to their story. When we know more about how they started, you may understand why they can do what they can do!

This month, we're learning about our origin story with God! We are going to learn where it all began, the origins of us, our relationship with God, and the origins of the world itself!

GAME TIME

But before we jump into that, let's play a game! Since our theme this month is 'origin story,' we thought it might be fun to play a superhero game! Let's try this with a game I like to call 'Super-moji.'

SLIDE: Super-Moji

So here is how you play, I'm going to have a slide that has some emojis on it representing the name of a superhero. I need you to raise your hand if you know the answer. Are you ready?

As you show the slides, make comments with kids about your favorite superheroes. You may need to give some help if kids are struggling to guess the name.

SLIDE: Spider-Man 🕷️ + 👤

SLIDE: Aquaman 💧 + 👤

SLIDE: Green Lantern 🟢 + 👤

SLIDE Iron Man 🛡️ + 👤

SLIDE: Robin 🦇

Great job! You guys really know your superheroes! Now let's go focus our attention in worship on the One who did the most heroic thing in history.

One of the ways we worship is by giving praise and honor to God by singing and dancing. Now, is your time to jump in and give all you've got as we worship! You can follow along to the moves or worship in your own way. Let's sing!

Show Series Theme Graphic: Origin Story

Hey, friends! I want to share something special that we're doing for this next year! As we start this new school year, we're going to be going through the story of the ENTIRE Bible together.

There are a ton of the awesome stories in the Bible. God gave us the Bible so we can know about Him! We're going to learn Bible stories, yes. But more importantly, we're going to get to know God! So let's start right at the beginning of the Bible, in the book of Genesis! Genesis is the very first book in the Bible! It's a part of a section of the Bible called 'The Old Testament.' *(Hold up Bible.)* Let's check out today's story!

[BOTTOM LINE] You can trust God no matter what.

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Through all the ups and downs, we can trust that God loves us. God has been working on His great rescue plan for a long, long time. He is going to fix everything. That means He loves us so, so much and He is always working for our good. We can trust Him. We can believe God wants what's best for us, no matter what. We can choose to have faith in Him.

Show Graphic: Virtue

Faith means trusting in what you can't see because of what you can see.

Faith can be kind of a hard thing to learn about, because it means trusting in Jesus, even when we can't see Him. This is what the Bible has to say about it.

Show Verse: Hebrews 11:1 (NirV)

Let's say it together! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Before you go to groups, let's pray and ask God to help us live in His great love for us.
