## OPENER

(Welcome kids)

Friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! My name is (your name), and it's my favorite time of the week because I get to learn about Jesus with you!

We're learning how to love others this month because Jesus loves us and wants to be our friend forever! When I ask, "Who made everything?" I want you to say, **[Bottom Line]** "God made everything."

(Ask the group) "Who made everything?"

(Kids and leaders respond) **[Bottom Line]** "God made everything."

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## WORSHIP

Yes! **[Bottom Line]** "God made everything." Let's worship together to celebrate that! Everyone, stand up, join in, and let's sing some songs about all the good things God made!

Thanks for celebrating God with me! And now it's time to turn around (spin around)... sit down.

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## BIG GROUP GAME

Do you know what this is? (Hold up spaceship.) That's right! It's a spaceship! (pretend to

I'm pretending to be an astronaut. An astronaut is a person who goes to space. I'm pretending to fly my spaceship and explore everything!

I can see so many things from space! I can see the big blue ocean. Can you make ocean waves with your arms, like this? (Move your arms in waves.) Wow! All of your waves made a big, beautiful ocean!

I can also see the big, cloudy sky. Can you pretend to be a big, puffy cloud?

(Pretend to be a cloud by holding your arms out in a curved shape and puffing up your cheeks. Slowly tilt your body back and forth as if floating in the air.)

Those are some great clouds!

*(Fly the cardboard spaceship around the storytelling area and then land the spaceship.)*

Hey, that reminds me of a story from the Bible, found in the book of Genesis. It's about the One who made everything we see. Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (**wiggle hands**) so we can hear (**cup hands behind ears**) what the story's all about!

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## INTRO

**Show Series Graphic: To the Moon and Back**

*(Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.)* Today's true story from the Bible begins in the very beginning. In the very beginning, there was nothing. No people, no animals, no land, no ocean, no sun, just nothing... but there was God. God decided to make the heavens and the whole, wide world! Let's visit our friends at the Clubhouse to hear what happens.

*(Open Bible)* There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. The Bible teaches us in Genesis 1:31, **"God saw everything he had made. And it was very good."**

Let's learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

**Show Verse: Genesis 1:31**

**God** *(flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down)*

**Saw everything he had made. (*Binocular eyes.*)**

**And it was very good, (*two thumbs-up*)**

**Genesis 1:31 (*open hands like a book*)**

*(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)*

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

*(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)*
