OPENER

(Welcome kids)

Friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! My name is *(your name)*, and it's my favorite time of the week because we are learning about God and the whole world he made! **[Bottom Line] God made everything.**

When I ask, "Who made everything?" I want you to say, **[Bottom Line] "God made everything."**

(Ask the group) "Who made everything?"

(Kids and leaders respond) [Bottom Line] "God made everything."

WORSHIP

Yes! **[Bottom Line] "God made everything."** Let's sing about that! Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

Show Worship: What God Made

Show Worship: King of the Jungle

Thanks for worshipping with me today! Sit right down!

BIG GROUP GAME

Look at my telescope. It helps me see things far away. Oh! I see some friends wearing the color red.

Hold up and look at the kids through telescope.

Can you use your pretend telescope to see our friends wearing red?

Look around the room.

Stand up if you are wearing something red. God made all our friends wearing red.

Okay, stay standing if you are wearing red, and let's look for another color from the rainbow. What about the color blue? Is there anybody wearing something blue?

Look through your pretend telescope.

Use your pretend telescope to see our friends wearing blue! Stand up if you are wearing something blue. God made all our friends wearing blue.

Continue calling out other colors until all children and adults are standing.

“Wow, look around, friends! Everyone is standing now, and God made everyone! God made you *(point)* and **[Basic Truth] God made me.** *(Point to self).*”

Now it’s time to turn around *(spin around)* ...sit down *(sit down)* . . . shake the wiggles out *(wiggle hands)* . . . so we can hear *(cup hands behind ears)* what the story’s all about!”

APPLICATION

God made ALL the land and plants and seas! God made everything! Now, when you look around at the great big world and see trees and grass and flowers, you can say, **[Bottom Line] God made everything!**’

(Ask the group) **“Who made everything?”**

(Kids and leaders respond) **[Bottom Line] “God made everything.”**

Bible Verse

(Open Bible) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. The Bible teaches us in Genesis 1:31, **“God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.”**

Let's learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Video: Memory Verse Motions

Show Verse: Genesis 1:31

God (*flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down*)

Saw everything he had made. (*Binocular eyes.*)

And it was very good, (*two thumbs-up*)

Genesis 1:31 (*open hands like a book*)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You so much for this beautiful world You have created for us. We get to enjoy the light and the dark, the sky and water, and we get to enjoy the land, all the different kinds of plants, and the seas. We love you and are so thankful for this world. In Jesus' name. Amen.
