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## OPENER

*(Welcome kids)*

Hi friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! It's my favorite time of the week because worshipping with you is my very favorite thing! We worship together to show Jesus how much we love Him. Jesus wants to be our friend forever, and Jesus will help us do what he says.

*(Ask the group)* **"Who made everything?"**

*(Kids and leaders respond)* **[Bottom Line] "God made everything."**

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## WORSHIP

Yes! **[Bottom Line] "God made everything."** Now let's worship! Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

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## BIG GROUP GAME

Keep standing with me and spread out. Can you spread your arms out REALLY wide like this?

*Holds arms out wide with flat hands.*

Make yourself really, really big! Now, let's count to three and clap our hands together. Ready?

**CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER:** "One... two... three!"

*Clap your hands together in front of you, then hold your hands flat together to make a fish.*

Wow, that was a big clap!

*Make your "fish" swim by moving your hands together back and forth.*

“Oh! (Look at your swimming fish.) Hey, look at this! My hands look like a little fish swimming in the sea. Can you make a fish with me? Show me how your fish can swim in the sea.

Look at the children’s fish as you continue making your “fish” swim.

Such good little fish! Can you jump out of the water like a dolphin? Stand and jump out of the water like a dolphin.

*Jump in place with your feet together and arms close to your sides.*

Good job, little dolphins! What animal flaps their wings and flies high in the sky? (*Listen.*) Yes, birds! Can you flap your arms like a bird?

*Flap your arms like the wings of a bird.*

You look like big, beautiful birds! Now, can you move like a teeny, tiny hummingbird?

*Bend your arms at the elbows to bring your hands near your shoulders. Flap your hands in quick, short motions.*

Oh, you make fantastic hummingbirds!

The Bible teaches us that **[Bottom Line] God made everything**—fish, dolphins, birds, and even YOU! God made you (*point*), and **[Basic Truth] God made me!** (*Point to self.*)

That was so fun! Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (**wiggle hands**) so we can hear (**cup hands behind ears**) what the story’s all about!

I can’t wait to share a true story from the Bible with you! (**Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.**) Today’s true story from the Bible begins in the very beginning. In the beginning, there was nothing. Nothing but God was there! Then He made the heavens and the whole, wide world! Let’s visit our friends at the Clubhouse.

### Show Series Graphic: To the Moon and Back

Wow! Now, when you look around at the great big world and see fish and birds, you can say, ‘Wow! **[Bottom Line] God made everything!’ Who made everything?**

(Ask the group) **“Who made everything?”**

(Kids and leaders respond) **[Bottom Line] “God made everything.”**

Yes! **[Bottom Line] “God made everything.”**

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### Bible Verse

(Open Bible) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. The Bible teaches us in Genesis 1:31, **“God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.”**

Let’s learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let’s watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

**Show Video: Memory Verse Motions**

**Show Verse: Genesis 1:31**

**God** (*flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down*)

**Saw everything he had made.** (*Binocular eyes.*)

**And it was very good,** (*two thumbs-up*)

**Genesis 1:31** (*open hands like a book*)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let’s sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

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### PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for this amazing world You created. Today, we really want to thank you for the fish and the birds. They are amazing, and so are you! Help us to remember You made everything. In Jesus’ name. Amen.
