



WEEK FOUR – AUGUST 2025 – TODDLERS

Bible Story: *Creation | Genesis 1:3-2:3*

Key Question: *Who made everything?*

Bottom Line: *God made everything*

Memory Verse: *“God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.
(Genesis 1:31, NIrV)*

Basic Truth: *God made me.*

Series Overview: This month, we are taking our preschoolers on an exciting journey to the moon and back as we teach them that God made everything. We want our preschoolers to know that this beautiful world they live in was created by our loving, creative, and powerful God. All God had to do was say it, and it was! Wow! So, what did God do after He made everything? *“God saw everything he had made. And it was very good.” (Genesis 1:31 NIrV)* Then, God rested. And that is what we hope to do this month with our preschoolers. Look at everything God made. See that it is very good. And then rest in knowing that our God is powerful and creative and beautiful, and He loves us to the moon and back.

LARGE GROUP

STORY TIME

Gather children at the tables to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need: Preschool Bible; People figures; toy animals; toy food; blue crepe paper streamers

What You Say:

“Hello, friends! I’m so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. *(Place all the items in front of you.)* Today’s true story from the Bible *(hold up the Bible)* begins when there was nothing. *(Remove each item and put it in your lap as you name it.)* No people, no animals, no land, no ocean, no sun . . . but God was there. Then God made the heavens and the whole, wide world!

“Everyone, cover your eyes with your hands. *(Pause.)* It’s dark. On Day 1, God said: *‘Let there be light!’ (Genesis 1:3, NIRV)*. And there was light. Uncover your eyes. *(Pause.)* God called the light ‘day’ and the dark ‘night.’ On Day 2, God put some water way down low *(shake blue streamers in front of you)* and the sky way up high. On Day 3, God made all the land, seas, and plants with fruits and vegetables for us to eat. *(Hold up the toy food.)* Then, on Day 4, God made the sun to light the day, and the moon and stars to light the night. Twinkle your hands above your head, like this! *(Twinkle your fingers up above your head.)* But God wasn’t finished yet!

“On Day 5, God made all the sea animals and the birds that fly in the sky. *(Flap your arms.)* Then on Day 6, God made the land animals *(put the toy animals in front of you)* and God’s most special creation of all—people! *(Put the toy people in front of you.)* God looked at all He had made and saw that it was very good! *(Give two thumbs-up.)* Then God rested. **[Bottom Line] God made everything.** And it was very good.”

What You Need: “Sea Animals + Birds” Activity Page; Dot markers; baby wipes

What You Do:

- Encourage children to color their sea animals and birds.
 - Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

- “**God made everything.** On Day 5, God made all the sea animals and birds. See the sweet animals on your paper? Use the markers to make them colorful. *(Pause.)* Wow! You did such a good job making your sea animals and birds super-colorful! God is so creative! God made the sea animals and the birds. *[Bottom Line]* **God made everything.**”
