Weekly Summaries

Week	Bible Story	Summary
1	Adam and Eve	When God made the world, God made Adam and Eve and put them in a beautiful garden. God loved Adam and Eve, and they loved God. God brought each animal to Adam and whatever Adam called each animal, that was its name! God wanted Adam and Eve to take care of the garden and everything in it. That means take care of the land and the plants and the animals, and grow food in the garden. God gave Adam and Eve really good things to do. God wanted them to take care of the world He made! God has good things for us to do too because [BOTTOM LINE] God has plans for me.
2	Baby Moses*	Pharaoh wanted to hurt all the baby boys who were Israelites. That means Pharaoh wanted to hurt baby Moses! When his mother could not hide him in her home anymore, she made a special basket for baby Moses. Then she put baby Moses in the basket and hid the basket in the tall grass by the river. Miriam, Moses' sister, stayed and watched to see what would happen. Pharaoh's daughter found Moses and decided to keep Moses safe. Moses' mom trusted God's plans. God had plans for Moses, and [BOTTOM LINE] God has plans for me.
3	King Josiah	Josiah was very young when he became king. As king, Josiah kept the people safe and helped them know the right things to do. While they were repairing the temple, some of King Josiah's workers found a scroll with God's words on it. When King Josiah heard God's words, he called all the people together so they could hear God's words too! After everyone had heard God's words, King Josiah and all the people promised to follow God's plans. Why? Because God's plans are best! God had plans for Josiah, and [BOTTOM LINE] God has plans for me.
4	Abraham and Sarah	God told Abraham, "Look up at the sky. Count the stars, if you can. That's how many children will be born into your family." (Genesis 15:5 NIV) Abraham and Sarah were excited about God's plan, but many years went by. Abraham and Sarah became very old. One day God sent three visitors to Abraham, and they told him that in one year Sarah would have a baby boy. Sarah heard what the men said, and she started laughing! But exactly one year later, Abraham and Sarah had a little boy, and they named him Isaac. Abraham and Sarah waited a long time for God's plan, and we can wait, too, because [BOTTOM LINE] God has plans for me.

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Week 1

OPENER
(Welcome kids)

Hi friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! It's my favorite time of the week because worshipping with you is my very favorite thing! God loves you, and God loves me so very much! We can say thank you to God, and we can sing and celebrate God.

WORSHIP

Now let's worship! Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

Show Worship: What God Made

Show Worship: Praise the Lord Every Day

Thanks for celebrating God with me! And now it's time to turn around **(spin around)**... sit down.

BIG GROUP GAME

Look what shape I can make with my hands! **(make a heart shape with your hands)** What shape do you see? That's right! A heart! Use your hand to make a heart like this **(pause to let kids try)**

Oh, wow! Look at all those hearts! Hearts remind me of love, and I love SO many people! I love my parents. I love my (NAME SOME FAMILY MEMBERS). I love my friends. Oh, there's one more person I really, really love, and that's God!

I also really love animals! I have a game for us to play. Let's listen to some animal sounds and see if you can name the animal.

Ready? Let's play?

Audio SFX: Cow

What is the name of that animal? That's right, a cow! Let's listen to another sound.

Audio SFX: Rooster

What is the name of that animal? That's right, a rooster! Ok, listen to this last sound.

Audio SFX: Lion

What is the name of that animal? That's right, a lion! Let me hear your lion sounds! Great job!

Hey, that reminds me of a story from the Bible, found in the book of Genesis. And now it's time to turn around (*spin around*) . . . sit down (*sit down*) . . . shake the wiggles out (*wiggle your hands*) . . . so we can hear (*cup hands behind ears*) what the story's all about!

INTRO

(*Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.*) Today's true story from the Bible begins with the very first two people God made. Their names were Adam and Eve. Let's visit our friends at the Clubhouse to hear all about them.

BIBLE VERSE

(*Open Bible*) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. The Bible teaches us in Jeremiah 29:11, "'For I know the plans I have for you', says the LORD."

Let's learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Verse: Jeremiah 29:11

'For I know (*touch head with fingertips*)
the plans I have for you,' (*march in place*)
says the LORD, (*point up*)

Jeremiah 29:11 (open hands like a book)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

Dear God, thank you for all of my friends here today. Thank You that we are learning that You have plans for us. Please help us do the good things You have for us to do. We love You, God. In Jesus' name. Amen.
