



WEEK FOUR – SEPTEMBER 2025 – TODDLERS

Bible Story: *Baby Moses | Exodus 1-10*

Key Question: *Who has plans for you?*

Bottom Line: *God has plans for me.*

Memory Verse: *“For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. (Jeremiah 29:11 NLT)*

Basic Truth: *God loves me.*

Series Overview: God made me. God loves me. And God has plans for me. That is the foundation we want to begin to construct and create for our preschoolers this month. We want them to grow up knowing God has plans for them that include good things for them to do. We want them to know they can trust God’s plans and that His plans are always best. And just like we can wait for birthdays and Christmas, we can wait on God’s plans too! Each of our preschoolers are building their own story with their lives. It is our hope and prayer that they will choose to build it with God by trusting that His plans are best. With God, we know they will construct and create a story that will leave a legacy of faith for generations to come.

LARGE GROUP

STORY TIME

Gather children at the tables to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need: Preschool Bible, baby doll, basket with a handle, green crepe paper streamers, toy or paper crown, scissors, and masking tape

What You Say:

“Hello, friends! I’m so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. *(Place all the items in front of you.)* Today’s true story from the Bible *(hold up the Bible)* begins with a baby *(rock the baby)*, his name is Moses.

“Moses’ mom wanted to keep him safe from the mean ruler, Pharaoh, so she made a basket and put Moses in it. *(Put the baby doll in the basket.)* Moses’ mom hid him in the tall grass by the river *(move the streamers over the basket hiding the baby)* while his sister watched to see what would happen. Someone found baby Moses; it was the Pharaoh’s daughter, *(place the crown on your head)*, and she decided to keep him safe. Moses’ mom trusted God and knew God had plans for Moses, and **[Bottom Line] God has plans for you.**”

CRAFT TIME

What You Need: “Hide Baby Moses” Activity Page, cardstock, green dot markers, baby wipes, and a permanent marker

What You Do:

- Copy “Hide Baby Moses” on cardstock, one per child.
- Write each child’s name on their paper.
- Encourage children to fill in the tall grass to hide Moses.
 - Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

“Can you point to baby Moses on your paper? *(Pause.)* There he is! See these lines? *(Point to the grass outlines.)* Use the marker to fill them in so they can become the tall, tall grass and hide baby Moses. *(Pause.)* Great job! Moses’ mom hid him in the tall, tall grass to keep him safe because she knew that God had plans for him and ***[Bottom Line]* God has plans for you.**”
