WELCOME

(Welcome kids)

Hi everyone! Welcome to Flatirons Kids! I'm so excited to see you here today!

Show Series Graphic: Bedrock!

Hey there, builders! Welcome to Bedrock, where we're learning how to build real confidence in God—block by block! I'm [HOST NAME], and I'm super-excited you're here today. Give me your loudest 'Ready to build!' on three! 1, 2, 3!" (PAUSE FOR RESPONSES.)

That's what I like to hear! This month, everything's inspired by video games! We're going on some big adventures, and today, we'll see how trusting God can help us face stuff that looks ... well ... impossible.

Let's talk about that. Has anyone ever tried something that felt impossible? Like tackling a really hard math problem, or maybe solving a puzzle that was super-tricky? Or maybe there's something you wish you could do, but you're not sure you can. Well, today, we're going to discover how God can do the impossible!

GAME TIME

Game: BUILD OFF

But first—we need to kick things off with a little impossible challenge of our own. Who's ready for a build-off? (PAUSE FOR RESPONSES.)

Let me get 2 volunteers up here!

→ give each volunteer a set of blocks

Your goal is to build the tallest, strongest tower you can. But ... this is Bedrock, and nothing is as easy as it looks! Every round, you'll get a new challenge to make it a little tougher. Maybe you'll have to build with one hand. Maybe you can only use your elbows! Who knows? When time is up, we will measure the towers to see which one is the tallest!

We'll do each round for 30 seconds. Are you ready? If you are, you can start building on my go. We'll do the first round as a regular build. Build the tallest, sturdiest tower each round.

→ Make sure the kids are ready. Then start the game.

Ready? Set? BUILD!

→ Let the kids build normally for 30 seconds. Then once the timer has ended, see who has built the tallest tower

Great job, [WHOEVER WON]! Let's gently knock down our towers to start the next round.

(Play 2 more rounds. One round with eyes closed and one round with building with 1 hand.)

Let's give all our builders a big round of applause while they return to their seats! Sometimes building felt impossible, right? But you kept building. You tried new ways. And you didn't give up. Great, great job! I think today is the perfect day to remember: God can do the impossible. When things feel too big for us, we don't have to give up—we can trust that God is bigger. That's a reason to celebrate, and to sing!

WORSHIP

One of the ways we worship is by giving praise and honor to God by singing and dancing. Now, it's your time to jump in and give all you've got as we worship! You can follow along with the moves or worship in your own way. Let's sing!

Show Worship: 2 Songs

Great work, everyone! I love worshipping God with all of you. Let's go ahead and sit down and get ready for our Bible Story today.

INTRO

Show Series Graphic: Bedrock!

Remember, we are doing something amazing we're doing this year! We're going through the story of the entire Bible together! God gave us the Bible so we can know who He is and what He is like. He wants us to learn about Him!

(HOLD UP BIBLE.) This week, we're looking at one of the prophets in the Old Testament, Elijah. Elijah lived during the time of the kings when the nation had split into two. Let's

check it out!

Elijah's had such confidence in God because, over time, he had learned that God was trustworthy. Elijah built his confidence in God one block at a time—because God had shown He is faithful, not just on the mountain, but every day. Then that day on the mountain, God did something huge. God showed everyone that He alone can do the impossible. Here's what we need to remember:

***[BOTTOM LINE]* God can do the impossible.**

Say that with me! *(Repeat with leaders and kids)*

When we think about Elijah, we can remember that Elijah trusted God for the impossible. But Elijah's confidence didn't show up all at once. It's not like Elijah was just a faith rockstar all of a sudden! And Elijah's faith in God wasn't always constant! He built it, one block at a time, by listening to God, doing what God said, and depending on God in the big things and the small things.

Confidence is living like you believe God is with you..

The truth is, all of us will run into things that seem impossible on our own. But just like Elijah, you can build your confidence in God block by block—by trusting God each day. You can pray. You can listen. You can ask for help. Sometimes, God will fix the problem. Sometimes, He'll change your heart. But you will find the same thing is true as you go through life with Jesus. And that truth is this: always—always—He will be good.

This month's memory verse reminds us of this truth:

Show Verse: Isaiah 40:31

“Those who trust in the LORD will receive new strength. They will fly as high as eagles. They will run and not get tired. They will walk and not grow weak.”

Let's say it together! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Let's pray, then we'll head to our small groups to share more.

PRAYER

God, thank You for loving us and for being with us no matter what. Thank You that nothing is impossible for You. Help us trust You—when things are easy, and when they're really hard. Build our confidence in You block by block, just like You did for Elijah. Teach us who You are so we walk through life with You as our closest friend. We love You, God, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
