Weekly Summaries

Week	Bible Story	Summary
1	Esther	In week one, we will learn that I can pray, and <u>God can help me be brave</u> . The king is tricked into making a rule that will hurt God's people, but he doesn't know that Queen Esther is a part of God's people. Queen Esther needs to go to the king to ask for help, but she knows that she could get in big trouble if she goes to the king without being invited. Esther really needs to be brave, so she asks God's people to pray with her for three days. After they pray, Esther is brave and goes to the king. She asks him to keep God's people safe, and the king says yes!
2	David and Goliath	In week two, we will learn that when we remember who God is and that God is always with us, <u>God can help me be brave</u> . Young David demonstrates a bravery that no other Israelite has because he remembers that God is bigger than anything—even a giant named Goliath! David is ready to be super brave because he knows God is with him. So, David throws one stone with his sling. The stone hits Goliath in the middle of his forehead, and Goliath is defeated.
3	Gideon*	In week three, we will learn <u>God can help me be brave</u> —even when we are afraid. Gideon hides because he is afraid of a big army called the Midianites. They would steal everything God's people had and keep it for themselves. One day, God sends an angel to Gideon. The angel tells Gideon, "The LORD is with you, mighty warrior." (Judges 6:12 NIV) The angel tells Gideon that God wants him to lead an army to defeat the Midianites. Gideon doesn't understand because he is the smallest and least important one in his family. But the angel tells Gideon that God will be with him. Gideon trusts God, and he leads an army to defeat the Midianites.
4	Abigail	In week four, we will learn that <u>God can help me be brave</u> so I can help others. David and his men protect Nabal's sheep and shepherds so nothing bad can happen to them. Sometime later, Nabal cuts the wool off his sheep. It is such a fun time, they have a party! So, David sends a few men to ask if they can have some food from the party, but Nabal is very mean to them. He says no, and David becomes very angry. Abigail, Nabal's wife, knows she needs to be brave and help! She quickly brings a lot of food and drinks to David and his men, and David thanks God for her help.

OPENER (Welcome kids)

Hi friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! It's my favorite time of the week because worshipping with you is my very favorite thing! God loves you, and God loves me so very much! We can say thank you to God, and we can sing and celebrate God.

WORSHIP

Now let's worship! Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

Thanks for worshipping with me today! Sit right down.

BIG GROUP GAME

Can you show me what you would do if you were in the ocean? Would you jump in the waves?

→ **Look behind you.**

Oh, I see a wave coming! Stand up and jump with me. Ready? One, two, three... jump!

→ **Jump up with your arms out.**

I love jumping in the waves! Now, what if you were on a snowy mountain? A snowball fight!

→ **Pretend to scoop up snow and make a snowball.**

Everyone, make a snowball and throw it right at me. Ready? One... two... three... throw!

→ **Throw your snowball and then pretend to get hit by the children's snowballs.**

Woah! You are really good at making snowballs. Now, where else can we go? (**pause to think**) Oh, I know! I'm getting sleepy.

→ **Yawn and stretch really big.**

Let's go to bed! Let's pretend to put our heads down on our pillows.

→ **Lean your head against your hands.**

Oh, you are listening so well today! And no matter where you go—the beach, a snowy mountain, or in your bed at home—God is with you!

And now it's time to turn around (**spin around**) . . . sit down (**sit down**) . . . shake the wiggles out (**wiggle your hands**) . . . so we can hear (**cup hands behind ears**) what the story's all about!

Bible Verse

(Open Bible) Let's learn some of God's words from the Bible. The Bible teaches us in Deuteronomy 31:6, “Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the LORD your God goes with you,”

Let's practice this together! Everyone, stand up! Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Verse: Deuteronomy 31:6

‘For I know (**touch head with fingertips**)
the plans I have for you,’ (**march in place**)
says the LORD, (**point up**)
Deuteronomy 31:6 (**open hands like a book**)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

PRAYER

Dear God, No one is bigger or more powerful than You! Thank you for being with us and helping us be brave. You're the best, God. We love You! In Jesus' name. Amen.
