Connection Time Activity: These activities are made for kids to have FUN while connecting with YOU! Use this time to ask questions and engage with your small group!

Christmas Coloring Pages

What You Need: “Nativity” Coloring Page, “Joy to the World” Coloring Page, Crayons, Markers

What You Do:

- Welcome kids and spend time engaging in conversation and asking about their past week and upcoming Christmas plans!
 - If you have any first-timers, take time to make them feel extra welcomed
- Explain that today is a SPECIAL day of fun and learning all about WHY we celebrate Christmas!
- As you explain the day, set out the coloring pages and drawing utensils
- Tell them to color the page they choose in whatever way that they desire
 - Pro tip: COMPLIMENT their coloring skills! Every small thing you can encourage tells each child they are welcome, seen, and loved.
- As they are coloring, ask these questions:
 - What are you *most* looking forward to this Christmas?
 - What are you doing at school to celebrate Christmas?
 - If you could choose *one* Christmas snack/treat to eat *every day*, what would it be?
 - Do you hope it snows this Christmas? Why/Why not?

Christmas Charades

What You Need: List of Charades Actions below!

What You Do:

- Direct all kids playing to sit down on the ground facing you
- Choose one volunteer to be the first person to “act”, while the rest of the group is going to *guess* what it is they’re trying to act out!
- Explain that you will give the person acting a Christmas Activity to act out, but they can’t say a *word*! They can only use motions!
- Show them an example:
 - Eating a Christmas Cookie: Pretend to take a *big* bite of a cookie.
 - Encourage your group to guess what you’re doing! Help them understand the game by encouraging guesses and giving hints.
- Once they’ve got it, give your volunteer a phrase (using the list below) and say, GO!
- Encourage the group to guess by yelling out their answers!
 - You may need to help give hints depending on your volunteer
- Once the group has guessed, choose another volunteer to act!
- Play as many rounds as time allows

Pass the Gift

What You Need: A “Gift” to pass around the circle (Gift/Marker/Toy/Etc.)

What You Do:

- Invite the kids to sit in a circle.
- Explain that you’re going to play a game like “hot potato,” but with a “gift”.
- Sing a Christmas song, and instruct the kids to pass the gift around the circle.
- When you say FREEZE! every one freezes, and the kid holding the gift will share one reason Jesus is the greatest gift.
 - If they can’t think of something, maybe ask them to share in general what or who is the greatest gift in their life, and help them connect how that person or thing is a gift from Jesus.
- Younger kids may need a prompt like: “Because Jesus loves me,” “Because Jesus forgives me,” “Because Jesus came for everyone,” or “Because Jesus helps me.”
- Continue until the countdown to Large Group begins!

Christmas Tree Ornaments

What You Need:

- Green Cardstock
- Foam Stars
- Marker/Pen/Crayon (for outlining)
- String
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Tape

What You Do:

- Give each child a half sheet of green cardstock page and a foam star
- Instruct kids to draw their Christmas tree (younger kids may need some help from you) and decorate it with drawing utensils.
- Once they're ready, they will cut out their Christmas tree outline using scissors (younger kids may need some help!)
- Stick the star to the top of the tree by removing the sticky sheet from the back
- Each kid will receive a pre-cut piece of string to loop and tape to the back of their tree, making a Christmas ornament!

Roll a Nativity Game

What You Need:

- Roll a Nativity Sheet
- Piece of Paper for each child
- Drawing Utensils (Markers/Crayons)
- 2 Dice

What You Do:

- Give every kid a piece of paper and drawing utensils
- Follow the instructions on the “Roll a Nativity Sheet” and roll 2 dice at a time
 - Give kids a chance to roll the dice!
- Depending on the numbers rolled, direct the kids to draw the corresponding nativity scene
- Continue until the nativity is drawn!
