Activity Name: Busy, Busy

What You Need: None needed

What You Say:

We are going to get busy! Listen for the movement I call out and then we'll all do it together. Ready?

- Let's be busy and run in place! **(Run in place with the children.)** Okay stop. Wow you were all so busy running all around.
- This time let's be busy jumping. **(Jump with the children.)** Okay stop. Wow, you were all so busy jumping up and down!
- Let's be busy and clap our hands! **(Clap with the children.)** Okay stop. Wow you were all so busy clapping.
- **(Continue with different movements.)** Great job, everyone!"

We were so busy doing all those different movements and actions now we need to stop so we can go hear today's true story from the Bible. Let's go!

Activity Name: Lacing Hearts

What You Need:

- Heart Cutouts
- Yarn laces
- Coloring tools

What You Say:

What shape is this? That's right! It's a heart! Hearts make us think of love! Who loves you? **[Bottom Line] Jesus loves you!** That's right! Jesus loves you and wants you to come to Him. We are going to decorate the heart and then you weave the yarn in and out of the holes of your heart.

What You Do:

- Give each child a heart.
- Encourage kids to decorate the hearts
- Show how to lace the string in and out of the holes around the edge.
- As children lace their heart, lead them in saying the Memory Verse.
"Let the children come to me" (Matthew 19:14 NIV)

What You Say:

Look at all these beautiful hearts! They remind us that Jesus loves us and wants us to be close to Him. The Bible teaches us that Jesus loves us and wants us to be near Him. Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." That means you, and you, and you, and you! (Point to each child)? **[Bottom Line] Jesus loves me!**
