Activity Name: Move and Remember | Made to Move

What You Need:

- No supplies needed

Friends, come sit in a circle on the floor with me. I have a game for us to play. I'm going to walk around and tap you on your head and say, 'The Bible teaches, the Bible teaches, the Bible teaches...' and if I touch your head and say your name, I want you to stand up. Then you and I will hold hands and run around the circle together until we get back to your spot! Isn't that going to be fun! Here we go! When I say your name, stand up and hold my hand. Let's run around the circle together. *Ready let's play!*

What You Do:

- Gather kids and sit in a circle
- Play a game similar to Duck, Duck, Goose.
- Show them you will walk around on the outside of the circle and say, "The Bible teaches (touch a child's head), The Bible teaches (touch a child's head), The Bible teaches [child's name] (touch child's head) the best things!
- You and the child's name you said will hold hands and run around the outside of the circle until they are back at their spot.
- Continue until everyone has had a chance to run around the circle and had their name called.

What You Say:

That was so much fun, I loved getting to play that game with you. Today, in our Bible Story, we'll hear all about ways we can live for God.

Lead your group to the Large Group area.

Activity Name: Love Notes

What You Need:

- Cards
- envelopes
- Coloring supplies
- heart stickers

What You Say:

Jesus taught people about God, how God loves them, and how God wants them to love others. The people who brought the woman to Him wanted her to be punished. So, Jesus stood up and told the people: "If you have never done anything wrong ... If you have always done everything that God wants you to do ... then you can punish her." And then Jesus sat back down and started writing on the ground again. One by one, the people left. No one stayed ... because they knew they had all done things God didn't want them to do. Soon, there were not any people there to punish the woman. Everyone left.

Jesus loved the woman and told her: 'Go and do what God wants you to do, because God loves you!' God did not send Jesus to punish us. God gave us Jesus to show us how much He loves us. **[Bottom Line]**
Jesus loves me. Jesus loves everyone!

Today we are going to make love notes. Think of someone who needs love, and today you will make a card to give them!

What You Do:

- Give each kid a card and envelope and 3-4 heart stickers
- Encourage children to decorate their cards by drawing a picture and adding the stickers
- Ask kids who they made the card for and help write names
- Help kids put cards into the envelopes
