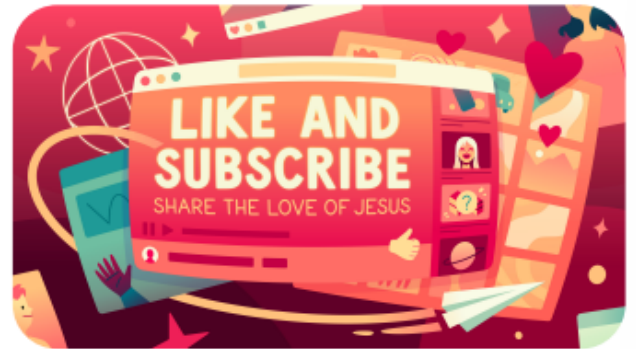

Great work, everyone! I love worshipping God with all of you. Let's go ahead and sit down and get ready for our Bible Story today.

INTRO

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Before we get into our true story from the Bible, let me tell you about something awesome we're doing this year! By the end of the school year, we'll have looked at the key stories of the Bible from cover to cover! Why are we going through the key stories of the Bible? Part of the reason God gave us the Bible is so we could know Him. He wants to be our close, close friend. As we go through the Bible this year, our intention is to learn more about God.

(HOLD UP BIBLE.) Today, we're going to look at what Jesus told us are the two most important laws in the entire Bible! And they have a lot to do with love! Let's check out our Bible story video!

APPLICATION

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You don't need a giant list to please God. You just start with these two. When you love God, you'll want to pray, worship, and obey Him. When you love others, you'll want to be kind, forgive, and help them. Aren't you glad Jesus made it so clear for us? He didn't say 600+ laws are all equally important and to obey them all perfectly! He said they are all summed up in two. He said the greatest commandments were to love God and love others. That is our Bottom Line for today:

[BOTTOM LINE] Love God. Love others.

Say that with me! **(Repeat with leaders and kids)**

When Jesus said, 'Love God and love others,' He wasn't saying figure out how to do that on your own. It's not always an easy thing to do. But He does want to help us with this every day! When you wake up and thank Him for the day, you're loving God. When you sing to Him in worship, you're loving God. When you obey what His Word says, you're loving God. And we can love others by thinking what our wonderful, kind, and good God would do, and doing that. When you share your snack at lunch, you're loving others. "When you sit with a kid who's alone, you're loving others. When you forgive your brother or sister, even when it's hard, you're loving others.

Let's take a moment to look at our Memory Verse for this month. It reminds us exactly what Jesus told His followers about love. Jesus didn't just suggest that we love each other, He commanded it.

Show Verse: John 13:34

‘I give you a new command. Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you.’

Let’s say it together! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

When we keep love at the center, everything we do—every word we say, every choice we make—shows the world what Jesus is like.
