I love hearing all about your guys’ week, and most of all, I love that Flatirons Kids is a part of ALL of our weeks – I’m so glad each and every one of you are here today!

Now here’s what I know about Jesus, Jesus is FUN! So let’s have some fun and play a game!

We need to use our ears for this game. Everyone, show me your ears. *(point to your ears).*

Great! Now get your ears ready to listen! I am going to make a sound, and when you hear me make it, I want you to make the same sound.

Ready? Let's play!

Boing! Boing! Boing! Stand up and do that with me.

As you make the sound, jump up and down like you are a bouncy ball. Children and leaders join in.

What do we sound like? (Pause.) Yes, a bouncing ball! Now listen to my next sound.

Cock-a-doodle-doo! Do that with me!

As you make the sound, pretend to flap your wings. Children and leaders join in.

What did we sound like this time? (Pause.) Yes, roosters! Okay, my little roosters, listen to my last sound.

Make a horn sound. As you make the sound, put your hand to your mouth like blowing a horn.

Do that with me! Children and leaders join in.

What did we sound like this time? (Pause.) Yes, we made horn sounds!

Great job using your ears to listen to those sounds! You know what we can ALSO use our ears for? We can use our ears to listen to God's word, too!

Let's listen with our ears and sing with our mouths our worship songs now before we hear our Bible story!
